
In acknowledging receipt of your letter of November 9th and to comply with the last paragraph of that letter please find enclosed Requisition Forms in triplicate to cover the material and labour needed to repair the drive shed and boys outhouses at the Mount Elgin Residential School.

Mr. James Clark of Deleware the carpenter who has built most of our buildings (granary, drive and implement shed and root-cellar) at this Agency did give me the estimate of the materials needed and does suggest that cement bases be built at the bottoms of all sectional upright pillars to make a permanent repair. He also thinks these cement bases would be better built in warm weather.

Mr. Strapp is prepared to go ahead with the work at any time the funds are available, cold weather or not, and I do agree with him that this work could be done at any time you desire to authorize the work.
