I regret that your letter of October 12th, has not yet been answered any sooner. I wished to consult Mr. Doucet before answering this letter and he has been away on inspection trips making it impossible to do so before the present time.

British Columbia has not been organized in the same manner as the other provinces as regards the Manual Training. Manual Training has been organized for quite some time in your province due to the British Columbia special grant. Supervision of this work was left in the hands of Inspector Barry and on his retirement in care of the Provincial Inspector. For the time being, the Department does not wish to interfere in this set-up. We therefore, suggest that you consult school inspector Manning in this respect.

It is with the understanding that the above suggestions will be followed that I am sending all the material that we have so far developed in Manual Training.

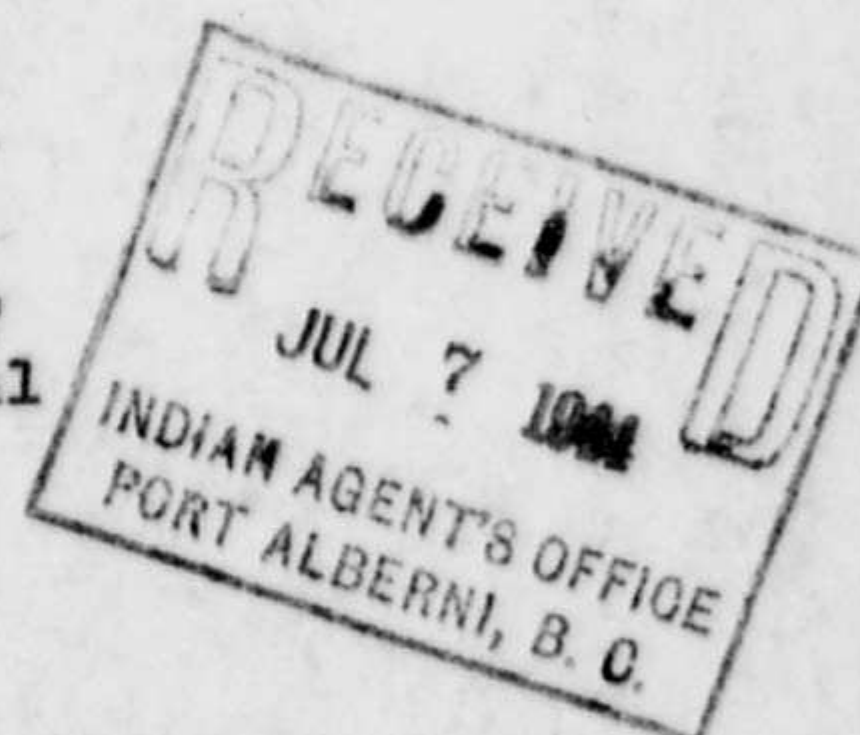

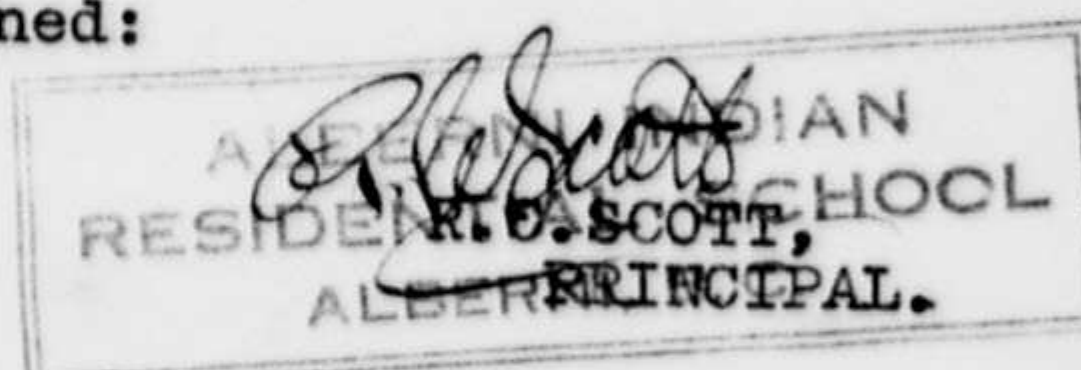

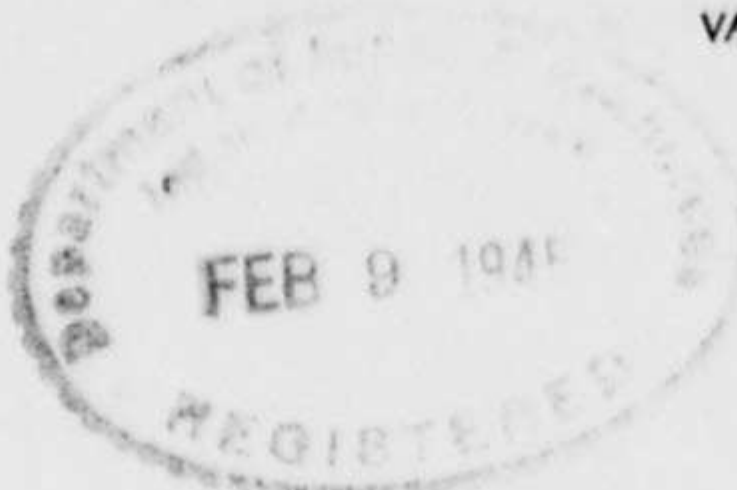
