
Sir,-







I have to request that you will have the Principal of the St. George's Indian Residential School, provided the same is urgent, submit a proposal with an estimate of the cost in connection with the erection of work shops at the school. Full information should be given as to the dimensions and the type of construction also how it is proposed to have the work carried out. When we have this information, consideration will then be given as to whether funds for the purpose can be provided or not.

Some time ago, the Principal requested the providing of cold storage facilities. The Department communicated with him by official letter of February 23rd, last, in this matter. If the Principal has any further recommendation to make, I shall be pleased to hear from him, giving an estimate of the cost.





Sir,—

I have Departmental letter dated June 18th, in connection with the proposed erection of Workshops for St. Georges Residential School.

When Mr. Commissioner Ditchburn was here he took this matter up with the Rev. Principal and myself, and we came to the conclusion that the old St. Georges School building might be demolished and what material could be got out of that might be used for building a two storey wooden building, the lower portion to be used for workshops a rough sketch of which is enclosed and the whole of the upper part made for a boys recreation room and gymnasium, as it is most essential that the boys should have a room of this description that they can use all the time for as it is now the present hall has to be used alternately for boys and girls, but if we had an outside one for boys the girls could have that in the school for themselves. It would be quite impossible for the school to do this work itself as it only means that the farm is neglected in trying to do extra work. We thought it the best and cheapest to let a contract to demolish the old school which will have to be done in the very near future in order to do away with fire risk to the chapel which is attached to it and also incidentally to save the windows and doors. You will notice that in the sketch one room is set aside for storage for as it is at the present moment one of the dormitories has to be used for this and with the opening of the new term the dormitory will be needed so I can't imagine where we are going to store the things that are in there now.




