

The table will be supplied with a 1/4" tempered masonite cover. The four legs will be fastened by the use of a metal clamp and stud type lag screw with nut. The legs will also have steel buttons to afford a minimum of friction when moving the table. The stringers are 1" x 4", securely glued and screwed to the softwood top.
