You will note from Father O'Grady's letter of May 3rd. and enclosure attached that almost \$24,000.00 will be required to complete the above mentioned building.

In my Army Signals message of today's date I recommended certain transfers to meet the cost of completing the Lakalsap, Kincolith and Hartley Bay Schools in the Skeena River Agency. I would now recommend that the balance of the funds appropriated for Old Fort, \$4,250.00 and the entire amount appropriated for Kitsegukla, \$18,000.00, be transferred for completion of the Classroom Block at Kamloops. The total of these two amounts is not quite sufficient and a further transfer will be recommended later if necessary as our construction program develops.

File 154/6-1-882, I wish to advise that I have had Mr. Swan check over the unfinished work of the Classroom Block and prepare estimates of materials and labour for its completion. These estimates together with the balances owing on sub-contracts of wiring, heating and hot water installation form the list of estimates on the attached sheet.

The delay on the interior finishing of the building, which constitutes the bulk of the work yet to be done, has been due to the wiring contract not being let before March 31st. last. However Wain & Son of Kamloops now have the contract and are ready to proceed with the work. As soon as the wiring has been installed it will not take long to complete the building.



We have your letter of May 5th with reference to the amount required in connection with the completion of the classroom block at the above school. The information which you supplied has been noted, and arrangements will be made to transfer the necessary funds next week.

In making the transfer for provision of funds for completion of the three schools in the Skeena River Agency, the following action was taken:


