MEMORANDUM TO THE DIRECTOR

Kamloops Residential School,  
Kamloops, British Columbia



It was the intention of the Indian Affairs Branch to build a Four Classroom Indian Day School at the above according to plans and specifications Index No. 836 prepared by this Service. However, before construction was started, it was decided that by heating the Day School from the Residential School the heating plant area could be utilized for instructional purposes.

The Indian Affairs Branch informed us in their memorandum dated the 11th of April, 1949, that changes had been made to our layout and they obtained tenders for the electrical work based on the proposed changes to be made. In our memorandum to Indian Affairs dated the 2nd of May, 1949, we pointed out that since we had no knowledge of the extent of the alterations we were unable to offer worthwhile comment on the tenders forwarded to us. In a discussion with Col. Neary, he requested that our commentary on the electrical work be deferred until such time as we were fully acquainted with the situation.

Our electrical engineer visited Kamloops last November during his western inspection trip and took measurements and prepared a plan of the new layout. There was such a great variation from our original plans that it was considered advisable to prepare a new electrical design and call for competitive tenders on this basis. We have completed our electrical design and have today delivered by hand to Col. Neary six (6) copies of our plans and specifications Index No. 927, which the Indian Affairs Branch will send to the electrical contractors for re-bid.

Our officer inspected the Residential School and out-buildings while he was at the site, and in this connection, we make the following remarks.

(a) Residential School

It is proposed to continue to use several of the existing classrooms in this building as instructional areas when the classroom block is in operation. The lighting in these classrooms is very poor and we consider it necessary to increase the illumination.

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(a) Residential School (Cont'd)

The lighting in other areas throughout the school is below minimum requirements, and it is recommended that general improvements in lighting be carried out as required to our specifications. It is also recommended that a minimum number of plug receptacles be provided thus eliminating the hazards existing through the use of long temporarily connected extension cords.

The present distribution system is 2 wire, 115 volts alternating current and we recommend that a 3 wire, 115/230 volt system be provided and that existing open knife type distribution centres be replaced by modern totally enclosed equipment.

(b) Out-buildings

There are a number of buildings located at the site, and it is recommended that alterations in the wiring be made to conform to code regulations and good practice. The electrical installations in several of the more recently constructed buildings is satisfactory and requires no attention.

In summary therefore, we desire from the Indian Affairs Branch:

1. Concurrence in providing a new distribution system and improved lighting and wiring in the Residential School.
2. Concurrence in providing lighting and wiring improvements in the Out-buildings in accordance with Canadian Electrical Code Regulations and good practice.

We estimate that the above mentioned work can be carried out under contract for an amount not exceeding \$4,500.00.
