

Reverend Sir :

I regret that for various reasons a reply to your letters of December 7 and December 17 has been deferred. This is on the subject of tonsil operations for your pupils. The Department is reluctant to think that 26 children definitely require the removal of tonsils. Reasonable funds are available and this will be your authority to have the twelve most urgent cases operated on at any hospital in Halifax where you can make good arrangements. It is thought that an inclusive rate of not more than \$20.00 should cover this work. In your letter you mention \$15.00 and it will be so much the better if you can get it done at this rate.
