
I wish to refer to your letters of October 12th and 31st, last, concerning dental attention for pupils at the Shingwauk Home. The Department is prepared to pay a reasonable amount for this service, and the work should be offered to Dr. J. A. Shannon, 659 Queen St., Sault Ste. Marie.

The Department's practice is to insist on only the necessary extractions and inexpensive fillings. In the case of temporary teeth, only extractions can be allowed. The fee set by this Department, where there are several children requiring attention, is \$1.00 per amalgam filling and 25¢ per extraction. When local anaesthesia is necessary when extracting, \$1.00 is allowed for the first tooth in the case of each patient and 25¢ for each additional tooth. Please see Dr. Shannon at your convenience, and, if he accepts the Department's proposal, arrange to have performed the dental work that is really necessary for the health of the pupils. Accounts should be in duplicate and should show the name of each pupil and the number of fillings and extractions. They should be certified by yourself and forwarded to the Department for payment.

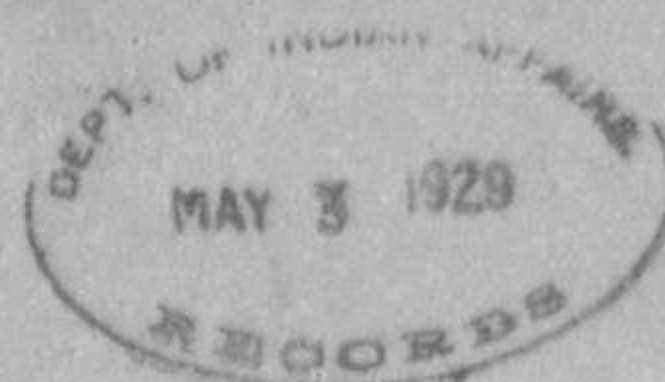

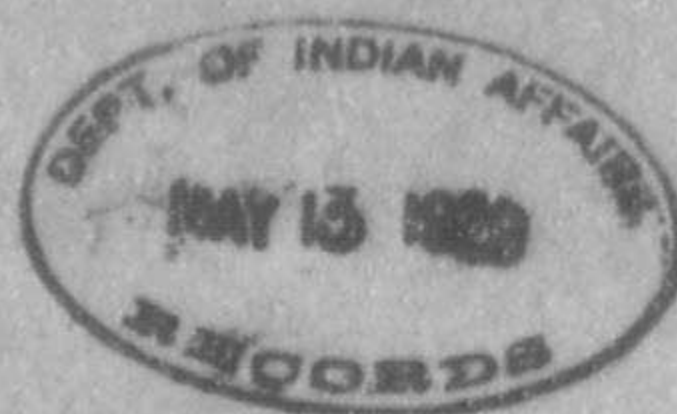

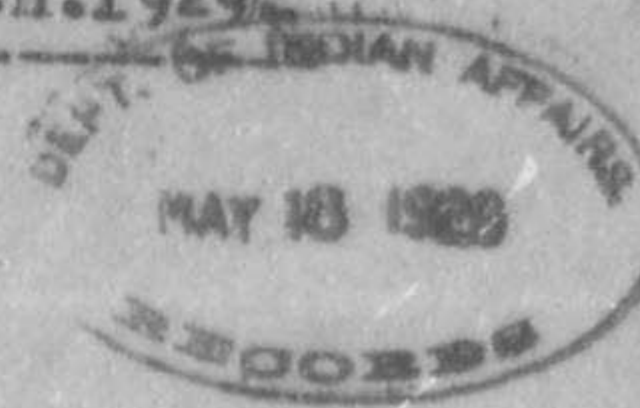

For some unusual reason these requisitions were not forwarded by us although we intended to send them. We have taken copies of those we retained for reference, and are enclosing our original copies.

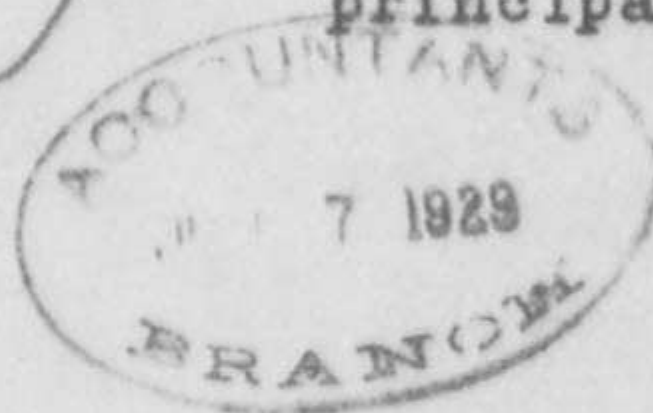
We are entirely out of all drugs and have been forced to purchase some small amounts.. Will you please allow any small purchase in case of real need, until the order can reach us..
