Dear Sir,

In connection with the building of the new barn at the Cecilia Jeffrey School. I think we shall build this cheaper than it was done by the Wyndels Construction Company under contract. The Principal wishes us to build a small cement pit for the water from the manure gutter at the stable to prevent its wastage so that it can be used on the land. This should not cost more than \$100. He also wishes the water pipes run from the stable to the hennerly and piggery. This would cost in the neighborhood of \$150.

The Principal also wishes to have hay slings and carrier installed in the barn as these were also destroyed by fire - at an approximate cost not to exceed \$225. I have authorized this and trust it meets with your approval.

I shall be glad to receive authority for the above as I consider the amount will be more than saved as the work is being done by ourselves on a day basis. Materials are being purchased from the firms suggested by the Department.

Sir,-

I have your letter of the 7th instant, in connection with the building of the new barn at the Cecilia Jeffrey Indian Residential School. In reply I have to say that the Department approves of the building of a small cement pit for the water from the manure gutter at the stable in order to prevent its wastage so that it can be used on the land. It is noted that you estimate the cost of this work will not exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00). Approval is, also, granted to have hay slings and carrier installed in the barn, the approximate cost of which should not exceed your estimate of two hundred and twenty-five dollars (\$225.00).

The Department does not consider it necessary to have water pipes installed from the stable to the hennerly and piggery. We are, therefore, not prepared to authorize the expenditure required for the purpose.

Dear Sir,

We forwarded to you yesterday, Pay
Sheets for erecting barn at the Cecilia
Jeffrey School.

We are now informed that the wages
paid are below the amount specified for
Government work, and are endeavouring to
obtain a copy of the correct scale of wages
from Messrs. Kelly & Kimberley who are bui-
lding the Post Office at Keewatin.

Would you kindly send us several copies
of the schedule of wages as we understand
that same has to be posted up on any work
being done for the Government.

We also understand that the Government
schedule is quite a bit more than that us-
ually paid in this district, and will be
glad to know if we will pay on the schedule
rates.

Do Indians come under this schedule
as we are not paying so high for clearing
land at the R.C.School here, and the amount
will go farther amongst the Indians and we
will get more work done for the amount ex-
pended, if it is in order to pay them at
the lower rate. We may say that the Indians
are well satisfied at the rate paid.

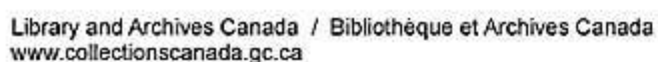

Dear Sir,

Replying to your letter 129-3-5 of 20th. Octr. 1930. we will write you as soon as we get an estimate of the Heating system of the Cecilia Jeffrey School, Mr. Oman is making a report for us at the present time.

With reference to the Water intake, we have received a letter from the Acting Chief District Engineer of the Dominion Water Power Branch in which they consider it advisable to have the necessary work done now, in case the Pipe settles during the Winter. They recommend that a 20 foot length of 5" smooth bore suction hose be fastened on the pipe at the broken joint, and this hose be extended into good water and rested on two small rock filled cribs, with another crib midway between point of attachment of existing pipe and outer end of the hose, and that the end of the hose be fitted with a good screen.

The hose is flexible and will serve adequately for years. The cost is estimated as follows. Hose \$66:00 Attachments \$12:00 Diver \$40:00 Cribs \$40:00 Labour \$50:00, Freight & Car \$7:50 and incidentals \$10:00 or a total cost of \$225:00.

We are ordering the hose and giving instructions for the work to be done, as it would be a serious thing if the water gave out during the Winter Months.
