Dear Sir:

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 9th instant, No. 117-2-3, in connection with voucher No. 832, in favour of Mrs. Roy, for a payment she made to Miss Kathleen E. Lawrence for assistance during the absence of a teacher.

In reply I beg to say that Mrs. Roy was anxious to try to keep the class-room open until a teacher could be appointed in the place of Miss Crockett, who was confined to hospital. She therefore decided that she would teach in the class-room, and to do so, it was necessary to have assistance in the preparation of meals, and the care of the sleeping quarters. I informed her of the contents of your letter of the 12th November, number 117-2-1, and particularly the last sentence thereof, but she still wished to continue with her intention to keep the class-room open and engaged Miss Lawrence to assist her. I did not give authority for this, but informed Mrs. Roy, after she had paid Miss Lawrence, that I would forward the receipt to the Department for consideration.

I was aware that Miss Lawrence was at the school for the week ending 23rd November, but made no arrangement for her payment. However, Mrs. Roy paid her for 5 days @ \$1.50 per day and it seems only fair that she should be reimbursed as her intentions were for the best interest of the school.
