

When the addition to the Cross Lake Indian Residential School was commenced, in 1923-24, \$10,000 was available. During the year there was expended for materials and freight \$1,821.64 and for labour \$6,240.20 - a total of \$8,061.84.

In 1924-25, \$20,000 was voted to complete the addition. There was expended during the year for materials and freight \$23,529.84 and for labour \$8,116.40 - a total of \$31,646.24.

Nothing has been voted for this addition this year, with the exception of the furnishings, which are not yet ordered. During the past two years, \$30,000.00 has been voted and \$39,708.08 expended. Hereunder are time sheets for labour, amounting to \$2,666.00, and later, I understand, there will be an account for lumber amounting to over \$900.

The expenditure has exceeded the amount provided and there was no provision this year for the last few accounts, as I understood that the building would be completed. However, the addition will have to be finished and furnished and I wish to recommend that the account for labour now on file and the one for lumber that will be presented in due course be paid.

Sir;-

I have to report that I inspected Cross Lake Boarding School on the 26th and 27th of May.

The general health of the pupils appears to be good.

In the classrooms the work was excellent, as usual, and good progress is being made.

The grounds are kept tidy and in good condition. There are quite a number of trees on these grounds which were not cut out, and these make the surroundings much more pleasant than the bare open so often found. The outbuildings are also in good condition. There is an excellent garden here which provides sufficient potatoes and vegetables for the school. The unusually severe winter caused a loss by frost of some of the potatoes in the winter storage root house, so that while the school had enough for themselves, they had no surplus as expected. Hens and cows are doing well, and furnish their quota for table use.

The school building is in excellent condition and well kept. It is a good example of the permanency of the stone building, especially when placed on a solid rock foundation. Some of the rooms were not so spotless as usual, as openings have been made into the addition, where work is going on, and dust is continually passing in.

Work on the new addition is making good progress, and the building should be ready for occupation in the fall.


