

In checking over the blankets for the school, I find they are in very bad shape and need replacing. You are aware of the financial standing of this school, and if at all possible this charge could be made direct instead of taking it out of his per capita grant, I would recommend it.

Paying a visit to some of the youngsters laid up with chickenpock, gave me an opportunity of inspecting the bed blankets. Needless to say they have been in use for many years and with washing and wearing they are very thin.

Our financial position being what it is, it is impossible for us to go out and replace these blankets. We understand that Supt. Rice has a large number of blankets from the War Assets.

Would it be possible that he might allow us one hundred and thirty-five, being one for each child? If Supt. Rice is to pay for them, could we have that number at the same price he is to pay for them?

The chickenpock will clear up in a few more days.
