The attached requisition has been received from the Principal of the Alberni Indian Residential School. On September 14 the Department provided the sum of \$100 to purchase the necessary science equipment for high school work at the above school. It is presumed that the equipment listed is meant to be purchased from this amount.

All the items on the attached list are approved with the exception of the microscope. Would you please discuss with Major Davey the necessity of supplying such an instrument to this school at the present time. You can then decide concerning the provision of the instrument requested.

It is also suggested that a table globe would be just as satisfactory and considerably cheaper than a floor stand globe, but here again you can decide with Major Davey concerning this item.
