

Dear Mr. Scott:-

I beg to inform you that on my recent visit to the Edmonton Residential School I was surprised to see that the roof of this building is in bad shape and will require considerable repairing and painting at once. A large number of the asbestos slate shingles have blown off and will need replacing. Upon examination it will no doubt be found that others are in bad shape. The ridge board has blown off and will have to be replaced. The woodwork around the windows and doors outside will certainly have to be painted next spring and an amount should be put in the school estimates to provide for this. In my opinion this work cannot remain over for another year.

Reverend Woodsworth, the Principal, has an idea that we should extend the fire escape nearer to the ground or build some kind of platform for landing purposes. I question whether this should be done. I think that if a fire took place some person could catch the children as they come down. However, I would like to have your opinion on this.
