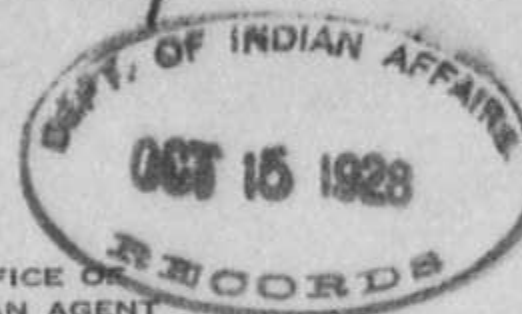

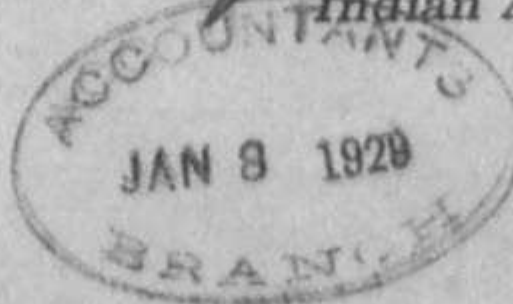

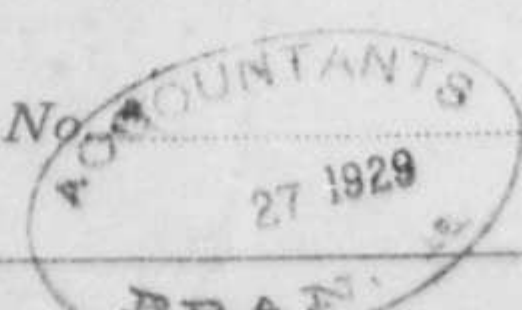

Dear Sir:-

For the last 15 years, the Department has rented a tract of land on the Reserve, west of the railroad, for the use of the School. The lease expires on July 15th. 1931.

This land has served us wonderfully well as a pasture. There is abundant feed for what cattle we have, and being well treed, it is a protection against the intense heat of summer as well as against flies.

What land the School has besides the above mentioned tract, is barely sufficient for our winter supply of hay and oats, so that if we were to lose this rented land, we would be forced to use our own land for pasture and consequently buy all our feed for winter.

The School has already spent a fair amount for improvements on this land. Last year we had to put up a new fence, the old one having been destroyed by bush fire.

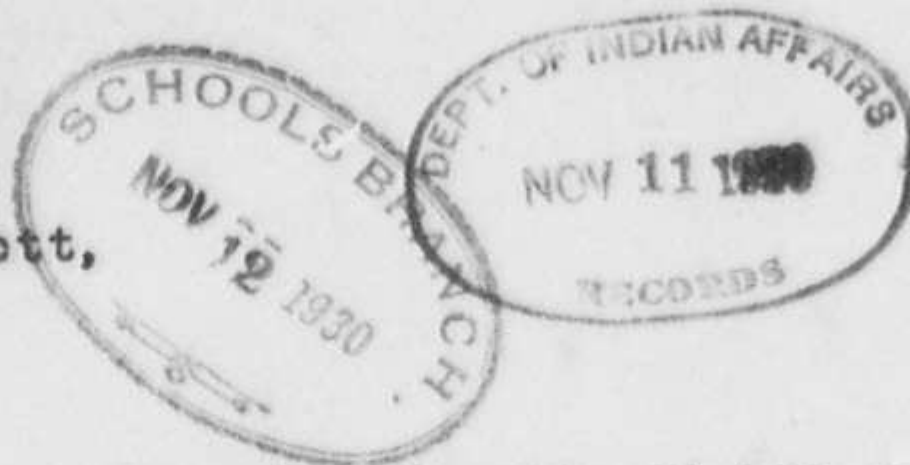
Furthermore this land is practically useless to the people of the Reserve, and will be so for quite a few years to come. Most homes are already built and a great number of these are at Frog Creek, about three miles from the School. We have, however offered those who wished it, to build their homes on the higher levels of this tract of land. There are a few good locations that would be well protected from rising waters in the spring, but so far none have accepted this offer, which gives further proof of the uselessness of this land to them.

Therefore, dear Sir, we would like to petition the Department to give Mr. Spencer necessary authority to renew the lease for an equal period of time. By so doing, the School will be assured of summer feed for the stock on this land and winter feed from our cultivated land.

MEMORANDUM:-

P. C. 1818 of August 2nd, 1916, authorized the lease of 75 acres, more or less, of Indian reserve No. 16 A. This land has been used by the Fort Frances Indian Residential School. The property actually comprised 88.18 acres and School Vote has paid to the credit of the band (Account 130) annually, \$88.18.

The Reverend Principal of the school is very desirous that this land be secured for school purposes for a further term. The school has many improvements on it and it is really needed for educational purposes. The question of paying a rental as during the past fifteen years is debatable. The school is maintained largely for the benefit of the children of this and neighbouring bands. Why should not the parcel in question be surrendered for school purposes and no rental charged? This is the practice practically everywhere else in Canada. In any case, this land is needed for school purposes and I should be grateful if you would take whatever action you consider advisable.

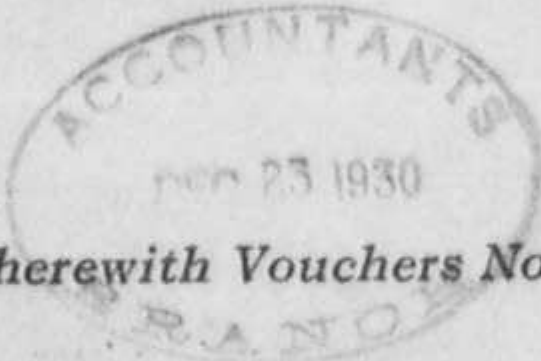

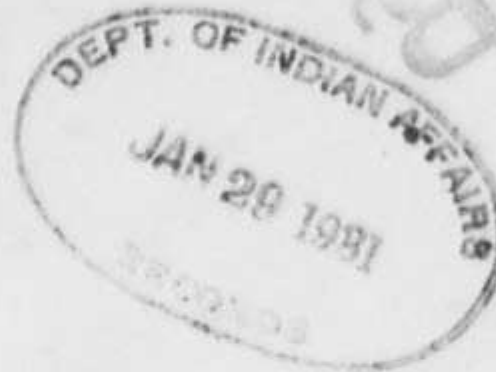

Rev. Sir:

I have your letter of the 26th ultimo, regarding renewal of the lease of the land on reserve 16 A used for pasturage in connection with the Fort Frances Indian Residential School.

In reply I have to say that Mr. Agent Spencer is being instructed to take up with the members of the Band the question of obtaining a surrender of this land for school purposes. If the Indians agree to the surrender of the land in question, approximately 88 acres, it would not be necessary to renew the lease. When the Department is informed by the Agent as to whether the Indians will agree to the surrender of the land, you will be advised. In the event of a surrender not being obtained, it will, no doubt, not be difficult to obtain a renewal of the lease.
