Dear Col. Neary:

RE: GRANT--Purchase of War Assets Corp. TRUCK.

Since receipt of your prompt wire offering us a 50% Grant in aid of purchase of Truck, and letter covering the same, several developments took place.

(1) War Assets wired us to cancel their offer for Chev. Truck as quoted to you in my letter, since it had already been sold. They offered instead a heavier, less suitable truck, (Dodge, dual wheels.)

(2) By the time we forwarded your offer to our W.M.S. and then altered the whole picture with the new offer from W.A.O., we found that our own W.M.S. are very short of funds. They tell us that we are already over our grant for Equipment etc. Therefore there is no likelihood of their giving us anything from the Grant.

(3) Therefore, regretfully, we shall have to drop this project for the present. I am particularly sorry after all your recent efforts in our behalf with W.A.O.

(If there had been any way that I could have personally bought the 1943 Jeep for \$340. you can be sure that I would have done so.)

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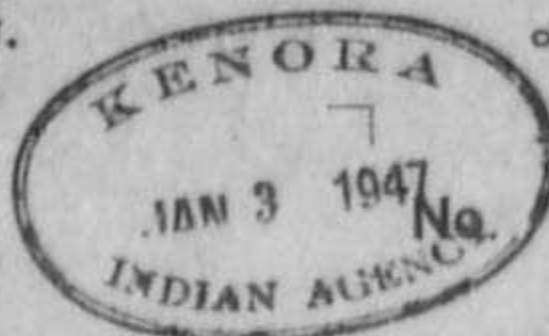

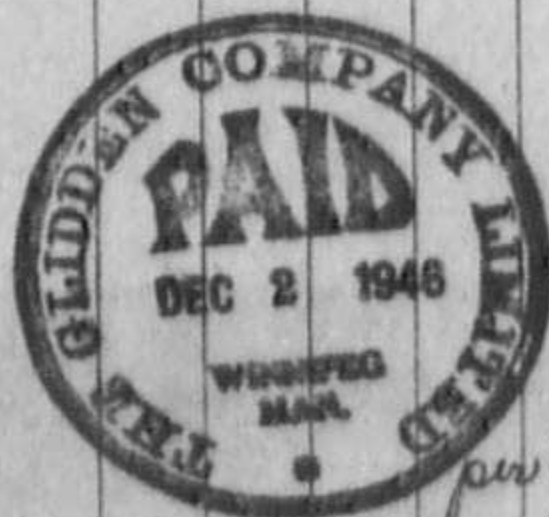
