In regard to our quarterly return for the quarter ending December 31st, 1930, the amount of the Government Grant as shown on the return was Five thousand, one hundred and nine dollars, and twenty-two cents, (\$5109.22), and the amount received from the Department was five thousand and eighty-six dollars, and ninety-five cents, (\$5086.95) leaving a difference of twenty-two dollars and twenty-seven cents (\$22.27). I would like to know why this amount was deducted from the amount shown on the quarterly return, as I received no explanation for the deduction being made.



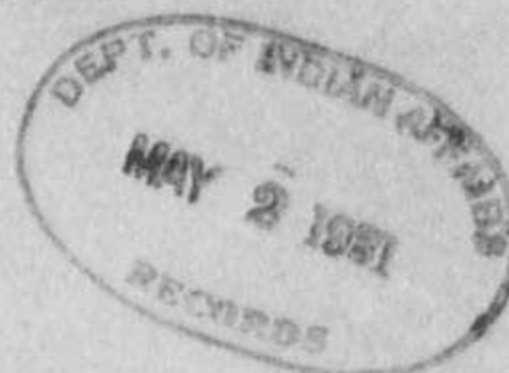
