



I have the honour to submit herewith Voucher No, 253, amounting to \$ 527.80, in favour of Mr, L, A, Pineo of Alberni, B.C for shingling the roofs of the Alberni Indian Residential School buildings, as authorized by the Department, s letter No, 159-1-5 of August 8th, 1929.

Department cheque No, 3021 (A20) amounting to \$ 250.00. dated Ottawa September 6th, 1929. was issued to Mr Pineo to enable him to pay labour costs connected with this work.

The Department also approved of the sale to Mr, Pineo of all surplus undipped shingles left over from this work, at the mill cost price, Department letter No, 159-1-5. dated Ottawa October 2nd, 1929. in accordance with that authority 20 1/2 M undipped shingles have been taken over by Mr, Pineo at the mill price of \$4.00. per M plus 2% sales tax i e \$ 4.08, amounting to \$ 83.64.

A credit note from Mr, Pineo for \$ 250.00, cash advance and \$ 83.64 for shingles purchased is attached to the said voucher the total of the credit note being \$ 333.64, thus leaving a balance in favour of Mr, Pineo of \$ 194.16.

Trusting that this will meet the approval of the Department.




Dear Sir:-

Enclosed find bill of Mr, A.S. Hanna, for plumbing done at the school.

This was a case of emergent plumbing, The large hot water tank that supplies hot water to the whole school is heated by a steam pipe from the boiler, we found the steam boiler filled with water and over flowing, On examination the steam coil in the tank had broken and let the water direct from the water system into the boiler. When we opened the tank we found the steam coil had rusted out and had to be replaced by a new one with new fittings as per enclosed bill.

There was no time to ask for authority, nor could we estimate the extent of the repairs until it was done.


