Confirming my telephone conversation with Mr. Phelan with reference to the telegram which you received from Inspector Hamilton, Winnipeg, in connection with the septic tank at Cecilia Jeffrey School, Kenora, I would advise that this matter was taken up with our engineer at Winnipeg and the following reply has been received:-

"Examined condition at Kenora school last Friday and while condition of sewage disposal system was very unsatisfactory did not consider there existed an emergency that necessitated starting new disposal bed this late in season STOP Present weather conditions favourable for immediate start on work but cannot promise satisfactory completion if weather breaks STOP If authorized will have new work laid out immediately and no addition to septic tank will be made this fall STOP In view of representations made would suggest that work be initiated immediately."

Would you kindly advise whether you wish instructions issued to our engineer to proceed with the work immediately.

Replying to your communication re the cleanliness of the boys' closets I wish to offer the following explanation; The school is equipped with the old platoon system which has been condemned by the Board of Health as suitable for public institutions. The toilets lie exposed and flush only as the tank is filled with a fresh supply of water.

We have no urinal and the boys use the seated toilets with the result that it is impossible to keep them clean.

It is not workable to have a supervisor present every time each boy uses the toilet and no matter how careful a boy may be it is impossible to use the seat toilets and not get some wet on the seat.

We are being criticised for a condition which I can see no way to overcome.

The toilets look unclean but if they are examined under a flash light the appearance is caused by rust having corroded the seats.

The toilets are scrubbed daily and we have installed a hose to wash them with hot water and this is done regularly. I really do not know what steps we can take to improve the situation with our present layout and if the situation were fully realized I doubt if we would be criticised.

I shall appreciate any suggestions which you may offer to improve the condition of the toilets but I do not see that closer supervision is practical.

We should have a proper urinal installed.

Dear Sir,

I wish to advise that, in company with one of the engineers from the Dominion Water Power Branch, I left for Kenora on Friday, November 12th. In the afternoon we laid out the proposed disposal bed. I also arranged for the labour and the work started the following morning. I might just say that the weather has turned considerably colder.

The total cost of the work authorized the previous week amounted to \$115.44, \$67.55 being for labour and the balance for material. The agent has the balance of the \$150.00 advance on hand but this will not pay the wages at the end of the week and I would recommend that he be supplied at once with an accountable advance of \$500.00. Some of the men may only be employed a couple of days and naturally will want their pay when discharged.

The material for the disposal bed will cost approximately \$500.00 and the order has already been placed.

I trust arrangements can be made for Mr. Edwards to receive the advance before the end of the week. Mr. Charles Stokes is foreman.

Dear Sir:-

I am in receipt of your letter of the 10th instant with reference to the request of the Principal of the Cecilia Jeffrey Residential School for a grant towards the cost of a store room. In official letter of September 2nd last, you were advised that, while only \$300.00 was provided in the current year's appropriation for the Cecilia Jeffrey School, we expended an amount of \$658.00 for a chlorinating plant.

The estimated cost of the new sewage disposal system is \$1,400. In view of the fact that the expenditures at the Cecilia Jeffrey School have already largely exceeded the amount specifically provided for this school, it is not possible to favorably consider the request of the Principal for assistance in creating a store room.
