

The Committee of the Privy Council have had before them a report dated 27th June, 1958, from the Minister of Citizenship and Immigration, submitting:

That Letters Patent dated January 20, 1958, issued to the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Burns Lake Hospital Board, Province of British Columbia, granting title to an area of land in the surrendered portion of Burns Lake Indian Reserve No. 18, in the said Province;

That the said Letters Patent were defective in that they did not properly designate the Grantee as the United Church of Canada in trust for the Women's Missionary Society;

That the said Letters Patent have been returned for correction and there is no adverse claim.

The Committee, therefore, on the recommendation of the Minister of Citizenship and Immigration, advise that, pursuant to section 10 of the Public Lands Grants Act, the defective Letters Patent that issued to the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Burns Lake Hospital Board on January 20, 1958, and recorded in the Department of the Secretary of State on February 11, 1958, under Reference Number 154458, be cancelled, and that, in lieu of the cancelled grant, Letters Patent issue to the United Church of Canada in trust for the Women's Missionary Society which shall relate back to the date of the grant so cancelled and have the same effect as if issued at the date of the cancelled grant.
