



Enclosed please find a voucher in favor of Mr. Harvey M. Davis. Lambeth. Ont. for \$3,083.94 being for materials and work at the Mount Elgin Residential School, Muncey. as was authorized by your letter 7-0-5 of Sept. 21st, 1936.

The cost of this work has exceeded the estimate made by Mr. Davis by a considerable amount and also there has been work done that was not shown in the estimate and at the request of the Principal of the school, no authority having been given for additional work from this office.

I did request the Principal of the school to approve of this account, which he refused to do, complaining that Mr. Davis had not completed the work to his satisfaction in so far as the cement work at the toilets is concerned and that there are no covers on the water tanks of the toilets which he claims were to be installed and thereby stop the pupils from throwing articles in the water tanks of the toilets. On taking this matter up with Mr. Davis he informed me that the style of tanks installed are of the open variety and no tops are needed.

Before payment of this account is made I would suggest that the work be inspected by a departmental official and approved, as this work was all carried out under the supervision of the Principal and on his instructions and this office only gave instructions as to the work stated in the estimate given by Mr. Davis.


