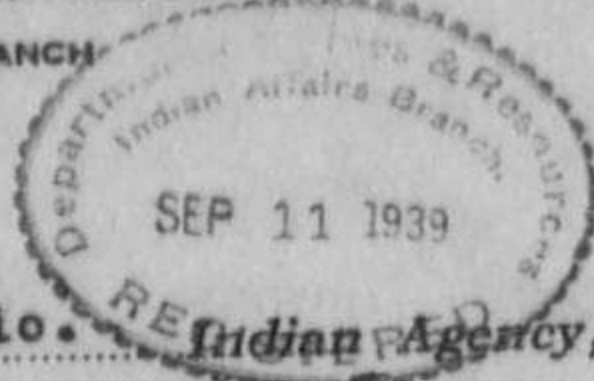

I am in receipt of your letter of the 5th instant with reference to the amount provided for repairs, improvements and new equipment at the Cecilia Jeffrey Indian residential school.

Since writing to you on March 21 regarding the amount available the Department has authorized a sum of \$200.00 for emergency repairs to the kelvinator at the school.

Under these circumstances the amount available will not permit our purchasing 75 mattresses. However, the Purchasing Agent is being requested to secure 50 mattresses 6' long x 2½' wide.

Re: Sewage Disposal Plant

I desire to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 12th instant in which you seek information in respect to the above-noted subject.

 You are probably aware that immediately following the creation of the Department of Mines & Resources, and the absorption of the Indian Affairs Department by the newly created organization, the construction of Indian day and residential schools, and all major repairs at Indian day and residential schools, was taken over by the Surveys & Engineering Branch of the Department. The officials of this Department accept full responsibility for the work undertaken and accomplished and the money necessary for all such projects is transferred from this Branch to the Surveys & Engineering Service from time to time. Inasmuch as a number of these undertakings require not only skilled labour but technical knowledge it is not always possible, nor is it deemed necessary, that full information should be sent out from this Branch to our Indian Agents. In the present case, however, I am sending forward herewith a summary of the work the Surveys & Engineering Branch had in mind when a survey of the sewage disposal plant was undertaken by Mr. J.T. Rose. Just how closely the men charged with the responsibility of undertaking this work will keep to this outline I am not in a position, at the moment, to state.

Dear Sir,

Replying to Departmental letter #129-3-5 of 9th instant re cost of new grates for the Cecilia Jeffrey Residential School.

The Principal Br E. W. Byers informs me that he has already ordered the grates from the Vulcan Iron Works Winnipeg the makers of the boiler, and that the cost will be in the neighbourhood of Six or Seven Dollars. He also informs me he did not wait approval from Ottawa as it was important that these grates be installed immediately.

I shall be glad to know if you wish me to obtain the accounts and forward them to Ottawa for payment or will the school authorities have to pay for them as they ordered them without instructions from us.

The Principal wishes me to ask the Department to rush delivery of the school supplies such as pencils, paper, books &c, as they were requisitioned for with the school quarterly returns at the beginning of July, and the school is badly in need of them immediately.

Dear Sir,

I have just received a letter from Mr. Edwards, Indian Agent at Kenora, from which I quote the following -

"Mr. Rose will soon complete his work at the sewage disposal bed, and the tank should be cleaned out. Mr. Byers asks that the Department pay for this. It is a question whether we should do it or the school. Instructions were given Mr. Byers that the tank should be cleaned out at least twice a year but this has not been done and the reason given is that Mr. Davidson, the engineer said it was not necessary. I asked Mr. Byers if the Department's instructions or the School engineer's should be carried out and he had nothing to say. Please let me have instructions as to this."

It is my opinion that the cleaning out of septic tanks should be included in the operating of an Indian Residential School and the expense, if any, borne by the school authorities. On information obtained from Mr. Gow of the Dominion Water and Power Branch, I advised Mr. Byers last spring, in the presence of the Indian Agent, that he should see that the tanks were cleaned out regularly. Apparently this work has not been done.

I would be pleased if the Department would instruct Mr. Byers in this connection, sending a copy of their letter to this office.

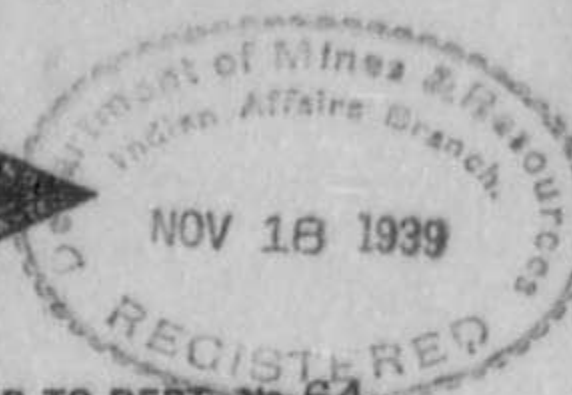


