THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL:

WHEREAS, for a considerable number of years, the land recently surveyed as Parcel "F" of Lot 7, Group 5, and Parcel "A" of Lot 9, Group 5, Yukon Territory, has been used as an Indian Cemetery at Whitehorse, Yukon Territory;

AND WHEREAS it is considered advisable to have the administration of the said Indian cemetery placed under the control of the Minister of Citizenship and Immigration;

THEREFORE, His Excellency the Governor General in Council, on the recommendation of the Minister of Northern Affairs and National Resources, is pleased hereby to transfer to the Minister of Citizenship and Immigration the control and management of the lands described hereunder:

Description

All those certain parcels or tracts of land at Whitehorse in Yukon Territory, which may be more particularly described as follows:

Firstly: The whole of Parcel "F" in Lot seven (7) in Group eight hundred and four (804), formerly Group Five (5), in the Yukon Territory, said Parcel containing by admeasurement six-tenths of an acre (6/10ths), more or less, as said Parcel is shown on a plan of record in the Land Titles Office for the Yukon Land Registration District under number twenty-one thousand nine hundred and eight (21,908); and

Secondly: The whole of Parcel "A" in Lot nine (9) in Group eight hundred and four (804), formerly Group Five (5), in the Yukon Territory, said Parcel containing by admeasurement three and sixteen hundredths of an acre (3 16/100ths), more or less, as said Parcel is shown on a plan of record in the Land Titles Office for the Yukon Land Registration District under number twenty-one thousand nine hundred and eight (21,908);

subject to a Caveat based upon an agreement between British Yukon Railway Company and Yukon Hydro Company Limited granting the right to enter and maintain a power line as shown on a plan numbered forty-two thousand one hundred and fourteen (42,114).
