Dear Sir,

Relative to the items of improvements submitted in our estimates for this year I would like to state for your information that the most urgent work is the shingling of the roof of the old barn.

If nothing else can be undertaken I would like this to be attended to first.

This roof is in a very bad state of repair and this barn is the only storeroom that we have for feed. Anything stored in it will spoil as the roof is full of holes and the rain runs through all over it. The floor is also rotting because of the dampness.

We have commenced haying now and will require to use it right away.

Mr. W.R. MacDonald gave me a price on the job including some repairs to the door tracks at approximately \$425.

I sincerely wish this can be authorized and I would appreciate an early reply as I wish to have it attended to at once.


Sir:



Sir:

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 14th instant, with reference to vouchers forwarded in your letter of March 14th, last, in connection with expenditures made by the Principal of the Cecilia Jeffrey Indian Residential School.

At the time the vouchers were received, our Appropriation had been completely assigned and, consequently, it was not possible to pay these accounts. Two Hundred Dollars was included in our Appropriation for the current fiscal year towards the cost of the root-house. Through oversight, you were informed in official letter of July 19th that this amount was intended for necessary repairs during the current year.

It has been decided to pay the account of the Williams Hardware Company, for \$268.77, and I am returning the other accounts, in order that they may be paid by the Principal, from school funds. However, if you have not expended the amount mentioned in official letter of the 19th ultimo, you may return the accounts which I am enclosing in this letter, and they will be paid. This means, of course, that you would not be able to make any further expenditures at this school for the current year.

I wish to state for your information that this lumber was used in connection with the construction of a Root-house for the school.

Mr. Sutherland authorized me to purchase the materials necessary and stated that the Department would pay for the same. The school was to provide all labor.

We have constructed a building which will last for a great many years and by doing our own labor have saved the Dept. approximately \$700.

If the school had the funds to pay the above account I would pay it and thus avoid any further trouble with the same but we have been cut down so low with financial assistance that I cannot possibly retire the account out of school funds

It seems to me that there must be some misunderstanding re the above account as Mr. Sutherland gave me definite instructions to purchase the material and to forward the accounts to the Dept.




