Dear Mr. Sims,

I have been asked to reply to your letter of September 9th enclosing the requisition of Mr. Hives for a sanitary spray. I have also been asked not to recommend anything that would cost too much money.

We know that the floors at the school are not very good and appreciate the reason for wanting an apparatus of this kind. I am allowed to authorize the purchase of a suitable spraying apparatus or gun, but I recommend one of the two following solutions for use in it, as they are both very cheap and quite suitable:-

1. Lysol, I.D., 1 tablespoon to 1 gallon of water.
2. Chloride of Lime - 1 pound, Washing Soda - $1\frac{1}{2}$ pound, water - 10 gallons.

Make a smooth paste of the Chloride of Lime in a suitable quantity of water. Dissolve the Washing Soda and add the solution to the Chloride of Lime. Let stand over-night and strain through a cloth or other strainer. Add water to make 10 gallons. This solution is very effective and will help to bleach the floors white. It will also bleach everything else it touches and should be applied with a mop rather than with the bare hands. It will corrode metal and should not be used in a metal operating gun. I recommend this solution on the ground of efficiency and cheapness.

The Department will supply the materials in either case, but would like to be consulted before any large expenditure is made for apparatus.

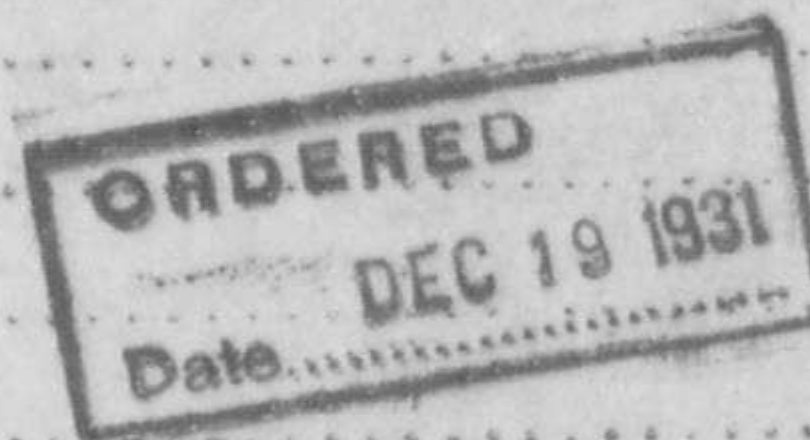
