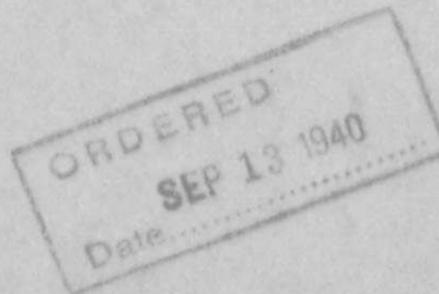

We have a few girls suffering from swollen tonsils, but one of them, Lila Simpson 01052 is really in a very poor condition. Would it be permitted to send her to the hospital to be operated. Dr Gibbon, Dr Harvie's assistant saw her; he thinks as we do but says he is not permitted to do it.

I also took upon myself to get glasses for Rosie Frank 0989 who is discharged though she is still here as we can't find her family. While she was in school all day she could put her book a few inches from her sight, but now we put her in the vocational class and she can hardly see a cup three feet from her.

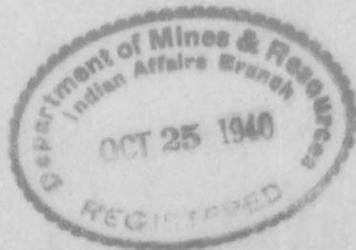

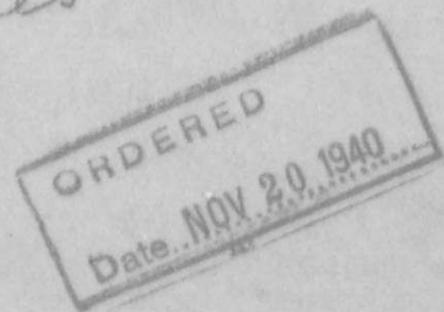

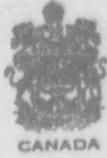
