

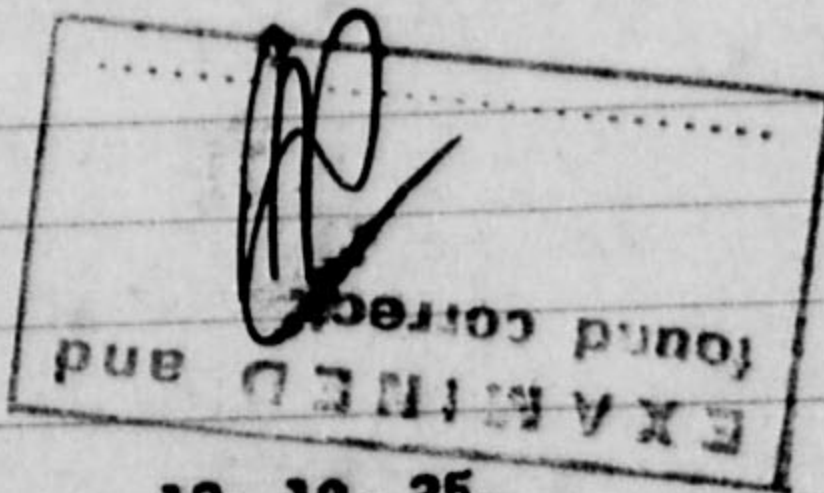

Sir:

I have your No. 408-11 of the 9th instant, relative to the request of Miss W. Tims, teacher of the Sarcee Indian Day School, to be allowed to teach on public holidays and during Easter week until the end of June, next, such extra time to be credited to her for the month of September.

In reply I beg to say that the Department does not approve of the school being conducted other than the regular teaching days, as it is considered that it would not be fair to the Indian children. In order, however, to facilitate the arrangements which the teacher proposes to make to visit Europe this coming summer, the Department will be prepared to allow her leave of absence with pay until the middle of October, provided arrangements can be made for a substitute teacher to carry on during her absence. The substitute can be paid as an assistant teacher. This arrangement is made in consideration of Miss Tims' faithful service, and is not to form a precedent for any future cases that may arise, as all such will be dealt with on their respective merits. The name, qualifications and experience of the substitute teacher engaged should be forwarded for the information of the Department.

Please inform Miss Tims and the local Indian Agent accordingly.

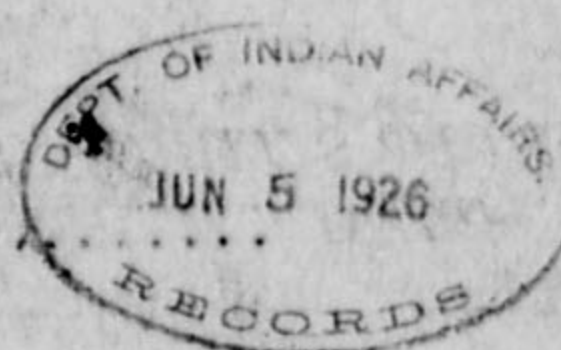
