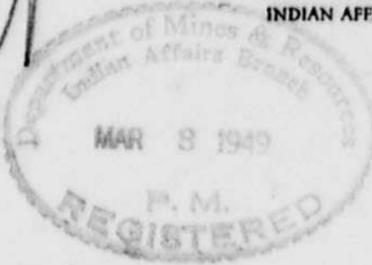

Your file 875-5 (E.1)

With reference to Mr. Pratt's letter of February 14th and Supt. Todd's report of February 1st regarding conditions at the Alert Bay Residential School, there has been some delay in dealing with this matter due to difficulty in determining exactly what is required and securing prices and estimates of costs. Even now it is apparent that some of the requirements cannot possibly be attended to this fiscal year. Mr. Todd has dealt with these requirements under various headings:

- (1) Electrical: Mr. Keele's report with regard to the wiring, etc., is quite comprehensive but is not sufficiently detailed to form a basis for a contract with him. Mr. Todd is being requested to discuss the matter with him with a view to securing a detailed tender on the work necessary.
- (2) Heating: We are presently awaiting advice from the Dominion Boiler Inspector with regard to specifications for the new hot water heater and the condensation pump for Boiler No. 44261. Items other than these as listed on the attached requisition can be secured locally at an approximate cost of \$410.00. \$125 of this amount is for a new smoke box for the boiler, delivery of which cannot likely be made before March 31st. If funds to the extent of \$285 for purchase of the other items can be made available

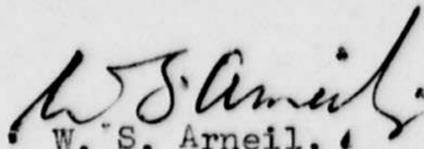

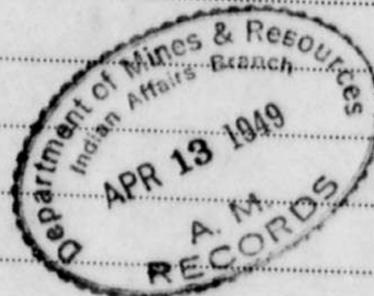
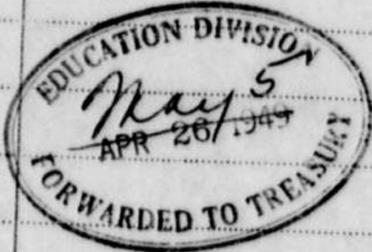
