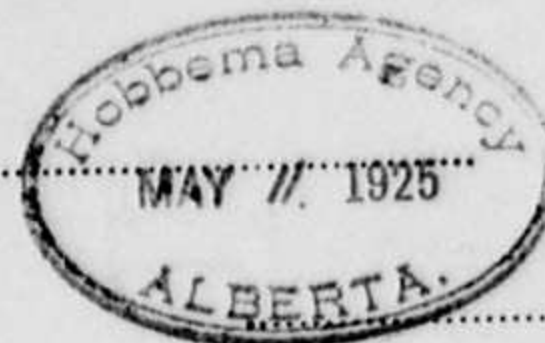


Sir,—

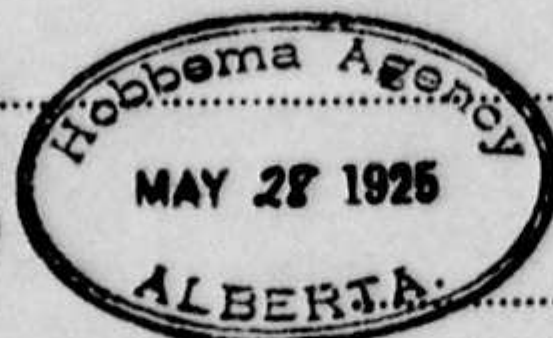

Sir:

The Rev. A. Barner, Supt. of Methodist Missions, Calgary, Alta., has written to the Indian Agent at Hobbema asking some assistance from the Department in repairing and re-painting the Church building, it being used as the Samson Day School.

An estimate by the Agent as to the cost of this work shows that \$250.00 would have to be expended, and it has been suggested that the sum of \$50.00 would be a fair grant from the Department to the Church in lieu of rent. The Church authorities would be quite satisfied with this contribution, which I think would be fair, and I beg to recommend.

As it has now been definitely decided to erect a Day School on the Samson Indian Reserve No. 137, at this Agency, it will now be necessary for me to estimate in my 1943-4 Estimates for provisions for mid-day meals for the pupils attending this School.

As this is a new departure, I would be grateful if I may be supplied with a list of provisions issued to Day Schools, and the quantities allowed per pupil.

It is also presumed that coal and wood for this School and the teacher's house will have to be estimated for. Is this correct, please?

Any information you can give me as to approximate quantities of supplies required by Day Schools which it is necessary for me to estimate for for the next fiscal year will be of great help and guidance. I presume that all supplies for the balance of this fiscal year will be looked after from our Branch at Ottawa.
