

Re: Cecilia Jeffrey Indian Residential
School near Kenora, Ontario.

On April 8th and 9th, I visited the Cecilia Jeffrey Indian School near Kenora, to examine the sewage disposal system and make inquiries regarding the water supply pipe line.

The water supply pipe line, 730' in length, consists of 4" wrought iron pipe, laid in the late winter of 1929. At present the line is working satisfactorily, but I am informed that on four or five occasions during the past three years, leaks have occurred and repairs were necessary. One repair job was necessary in the fall of 1939 and the latest in March of this year. In all instances it was found that the pipe had pitted badly and holes had formed through the pipe. As the minimum depth of the line is about 8 feet, the repair work is fairly expensive. It is reasonable to assume that the pitting is occurring throughout the entire line as the breaks have occurred at various locations and that the leakages will occur more frequently unless action is taken to replace the line.

It is recommended that the line be replaced with 4" transite pipe. This line extends only from the pump house to the pressure tank and is entirely separate from the suction line which extends from the pump house about 350 feet into Round Lake. It is not intended to replace this suction line at this time, as there is no evidence of any leakage in it.

In 1929 the cost of this 730' water line was \$1,813.00 and this was for labour and material and included no profit for the contractor. The costs for pipe and labour are now slightly lower and the estimated costs of the replacement line are as follows:

730' - 4" transite pipe, F.O.B. site	-	\$600.00
Labour	-	<u>750.00</u>
		\$1350.00

The pump house is in urgent need of painting and some repairs to roof are required. A sum of \$50.00 should be provided for this purpose. I would suggest, therefore, that \$1,500.00 be provided to cover replacement of force water main, repair pump house and to meet engineering expenses. The above estimate is based upon the assumption that the work will be done by day labour under the direction of this office.

I would also ask that \$250.00 be provided for the sewage disposal system. We desire to fence off the disposal bed, to protect the bed from natural drainage, to cover the bed with loam and plant grass seed. At present the disposal bed is being used as a playground and unless fenced off, protected and provided with surface growth, it will most assuredly deteriorate rapidly and become a failure within eighteen months. Last year, \$2,102.00 was provided to repair the disposal bed and septic tank. The work was carried out in the late autumn - the total expenditures being \$1,704.32. At that time we gave consideration to fencing and surfacing the bed, but decided it could best be done this spring or early summer. I cannot too strongly recommend that money be made available by June 1st for finishing up this disposal bed.

In reference to Dr. McGill's memorandum to you of February 28th last regarding the water supply line from the pump house to the school, enclosed herewith are two copies of a report received from Mr. Gow.

It will be noted that Mr. Gow considers that the pipe line should be replaced and that the pump house is in urgent need of painting and repairs to the roof. He also considers that in connection with the sewerage system the disposal bed should be fenced, covered with loam, and planted with grass seed to protect it from natural drainage.

In accordance with Mr. Gow's recommendations it is suggested that the Indian Affairs Branch be requested to provide funds as follows:

Replacement of supply line	\$ 1,350.00
✓ Painting and repairing pump house..	50.00 ✓
Completion of sewage disposal bed..	250.00
Engineering expenses	100.00
Total	\$ 1,750.00

These estimates are based on the assumption that the work will be done by day labour under the direction of one of our engineers.



Dear Miss Lang:

I have your letter of the 24th instant with reference to the Birtle and Cecilia Jeffrey Residential Schools and have discussed its contents with Mr. Hoey.

It is our intention to write immediately to the Indian Agent at Birtle and while funds are limited I feel certain that we will be able to supply the beds and mattresses that you state are required.

A recent report from the Surveys & Engineering Branch indicates that an expenditure of approximately \$1750.00 will be required at the Cecilia Jeffrey Residential School this year in order to place the water supply system and sewage disposal bed in proper condition. Our funds are so limited that I feel you will understand that in view of this very heavy expenditure it will be difficult for us to find any large amount of additional funds to expend at this school. However, unless something unforeseen occurs either Mr. Hoey or myself intend to go to Kenora about the time the new Principal arrives and at that time the school will be carefully inspected and careful consideration given to requirements.



I have received a report from the Ontario Department of Health, Division of Sanitary Engineering dated 19th. inst. informing me that the Cecilia Jeffrey School have 50 lbs HT.H on hand.
2. That the Tank of the Hypochlorinator was found empty and the following recommendations were made 1. That the dosage be maintained so as to show a residual of 0.2 0.3 ppm after fifteen minutes contact between the Chlorine and the water. 2. The Chlorinator be kept in operating condition at all times 3. The Chlorine solution check valve be repaired.

I will be glad to have authority to purchase another 100 lbs. of HTH and also to have the check valve repaired. I will send a copy of the report to Miss Carruthers who will be acting Principal as from July, 1st.
