

Ottawa, August 21st, 1944.

In reply to your letter of August 17th, I wish to advise that the Sodium Iodide Powder was not sent because it is not stocked by Central Medical Stores. Sodium Iodide Tablets, grains 1, however, are available and these can be sent if satisfactory. Lysol and Carbolic Soap are no longer supplied to Residential Schools. The "1 only 5 lb. tin" mentioned is an empty container which was used to enclose supplies usually broken down from bulk and have not their original tins.

I have your letter of the 20th instant, with prescriptions for glasses for children attending the Shingvauk Indian Residential School. Of the nine children apparently examined, orders for glasses are being placed for seven and these will be forwarded when completed. It is observed that "No change in glasses" is written on two of these prescriptions and no frame measurements have been given. They are for Lila Greenberg and Christina Butterfly, consequently, no action has been taken. Presumably, they have eye glasses and require no change at the present time.







I have your letter of November 13th and a pair of glasses for Abraham Mitchell, one of the pupils, which you report were received in a broken condition. Replacement of the broken lens has now been made and the glasses returned to you.

For your information, I should like to point out that the usual spectacle cases were not available when the seven pairs of glasses were sent to Indian Agent Laurence. We are also not very well equipped with packing material, consequently, we have to make the best of what we have. About three months ago, an order was placed for spectacle cases but, to date, we have been unable to get any action on it. This is probably due to the fact that material for their manufacture is still scarce.
