Both the Principals of the two Residential Schools here have requested that the grant for the nightwathman be made for the 10 month school year instead of for the seven winter months as at present. Owing to the fire hazard at these schools they have been keeping a man since the opening of the school year September 1st and intend to keep him on until June 30th, 1947. While they feel that the Department should pay for the full ten months they are prepared if necessary to pay for the remaining five months out of their per capita grant. They have also requested that the amount be raised from \$40.00 per month to \$60.00 per month as at present it is impossible to secure suitable men for \$40.00 per month.

I consider these requests reasonable and recommend them for your consideration. Round Lake School is certainly a grave fire hazard and though the conditions at Cowessess School are better the risk is still considerable.


