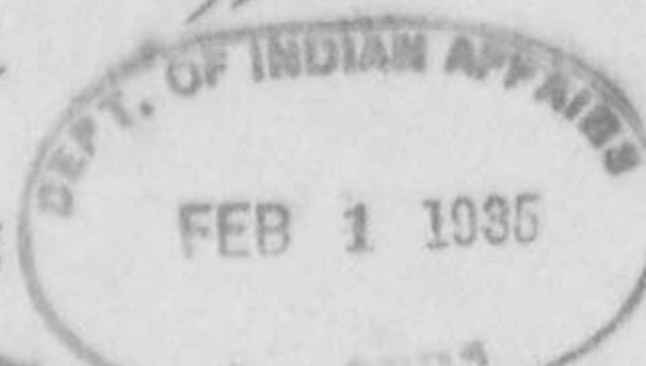

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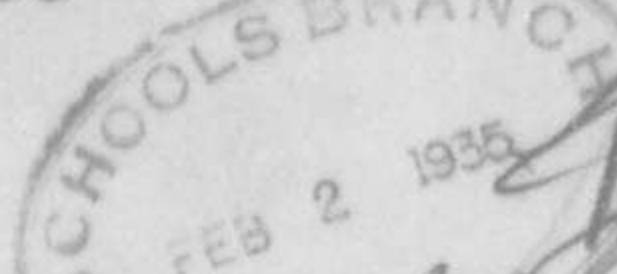

In your letter referred above you told me that you considered five days sufficient for the dentist's work.
