Re: Shubenacadie Indian Reserve Water Supply

I informed you in a memorandum, dated March 6th, that the sum of \$35,000.00 was provided in this year's estimates (Indian Education Vote) for the above work, this being the estimate of the cost of providing water for the Agency buildings, school, etc. on the Shubenacadie Reserve. In a memorandum, dated February 25th, Mr. Ross estimated the cost of providing the Indians with water at \$14,200.00.

It is the intention this year to provide the money required to build a 14,000 gallon concrete reservoir required for the storage of water for the Indians. The estimated cost of this work is \$4,200.00, and this sum can be made available but the distribution pipe line will have to be left until next year.

As I understand that money is required immediately, I am arranging to transfer to your Branch \$10,000.00 of the \$35,000.00 provided in the Indian Education Vote. I am also arranging to transfer \$4,500.00 from the Welfare Vote in order that the work may be proceeded with. The \$4,500.00 from the Welfare Vote is to be used on the portion of the system to provide water for the Indians. As soon as further funds are released by Parliament, a transfer of the balance of the funds will be made to you.

The Chief Treasury Officer.

Re: Shubensadie Indian Reserve Water Supply

The water supply system to serve the Agency buildings, school, etc. is estimated to cost \$35,000.00, and this sum has been provided in the Indian Education Vote.

In addition, it has been decided to provide water for the Indians and this year we intend to proceed with a portion of the work only. The plan is to build a two celled buried concrete reservoir from one portion of which the Agency buildings, school, etc. will be supplied with water and from the other portion the Indians will secure their water. Will you kindly arrange to transfer to the Surveys and Engineering Branch a sum of \$10,000.00 from the sum of \$35,000.00 provided in the Indian Education Vote. Will you also transfer from the Welfare Vote a sum of \$4,500.00, so that when the concrete tank is being built there will be funds on hand from which to pay the share of the cost of the tank chargeable to the Welfare Vote as this is a service for the Indians.



Mr. Phelan was on the Shubenacadie Reserve on February 7th, and found that the roof of the new day school erected last year was leaking. There was a very heavy rain storm throughout Nova Scotia on February 5th, and evidently the roof of the day school needs immediate attention as a large quantity of water came through.

Mr. Phelan discussed the matter with both Mr. Indian Agent Rice and your representative, Mr. Ross. The latter promised to make an immediate attempt to have the roof fixed. However, I would appreciate it if you would communicate with him as I think you will agree it is most desirable that repairs be made before too much damage is done.
