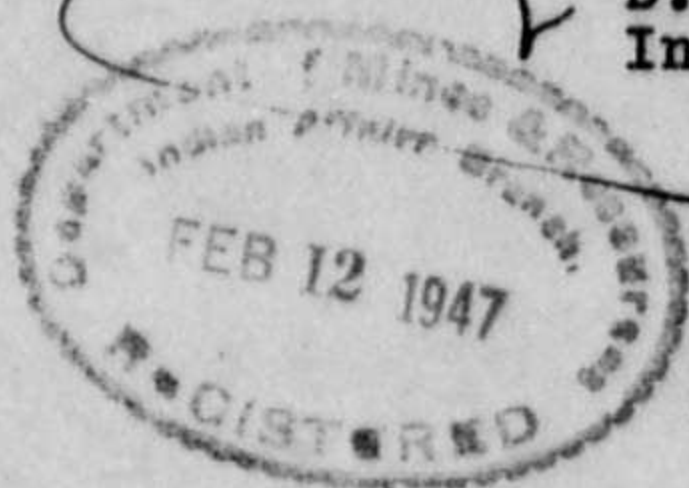

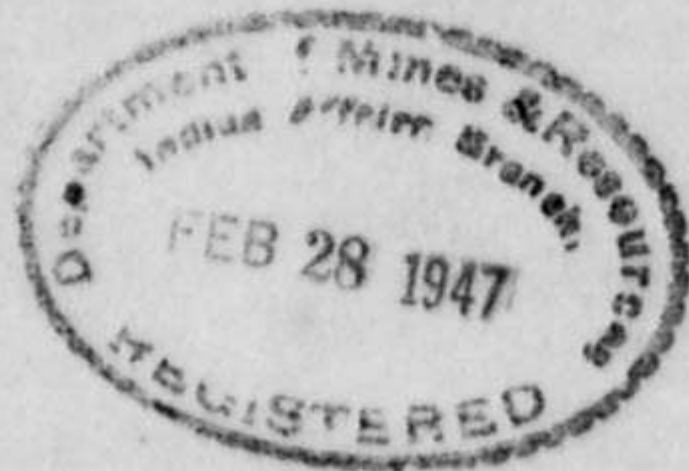

Dear Colonel Neary:

I am writing you to ask if we have any New England Company funds to our credit. We seem to be always in a state of penury these days. In spite of all the care we try to exercise with things like clothing, shoes, utensils and machinery, they wear out, and need repairing or replenishing. And prices have advanced so in many lines.

At present, we are in need of a conveyance which we use for light delivery, for bringing out bread and such like. We call it the Station wagon. In reality it is a Panel Delivery with seats built in so that we can take care of the transportation of pupils to and from home or hospital. It was bought in 1936. and is not in very good condition; especially for these mountain roads. I would like to replace it this year with another Station Wagon. Next year, I would like to replace the Farm tractor, which is in very poor shape.

If possible, will you kindly send me \$2,000.00 from New England Company funds. I assure you, we need it. and the very best care will be taken of it.

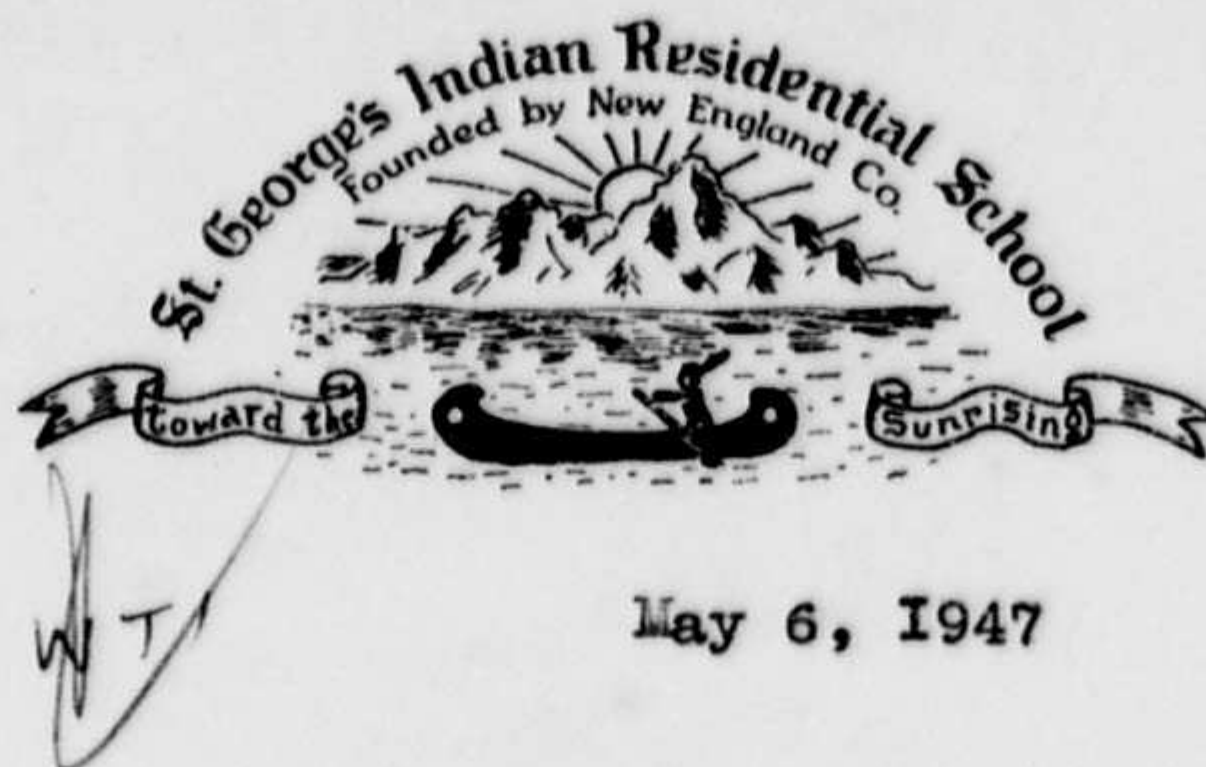

Dear Colonel Neary:

Last evening I had to punish seven small boys for going swimming in the river. The Fraser River is quite unsafe here for swimming purposes, and the boys are absolutely forbidden to bathe in it. So far, since I have been here, we have had no drowning accidents; but the Indian people are extremely nervous of their children playing by the river, and I am anxious to avoid any accidents.

We have no swimming pool, and there is none within fifty miles of us. Years ago a dam was built across a ravine, which was then filled with water from the irrigation ditch. This afforded quite a bit of fun for the girls and boys. But it was a very poorly constructed affair and has broken down and become useless.

Recently I received from the Department a New England Company cheque for the amount of one thousand dollars, for the purpose of buying a much needed Station Wagon, to replace the old one we now have. I have been told that I shall not be able to buy one until the latter part of August. In the meantime, the thousand dollars is in a Special account.

Will you please let me know by wire if I may make immediate use of this thousand dollars for the purpose of buying cement, reinforcement and lumber for the immediate construction of a dam, so that we may have a safe and decent swimming pool for our girls and boys. And in the event of this sanction from you, may we have a similar amount during the month of August for the purpose of buying the Station Wagon.


We have your letter of the 6th instant in which you suggest that the \$1,000. forwarded to you for the purchase of a station wagon be used to provide a swimming pool.

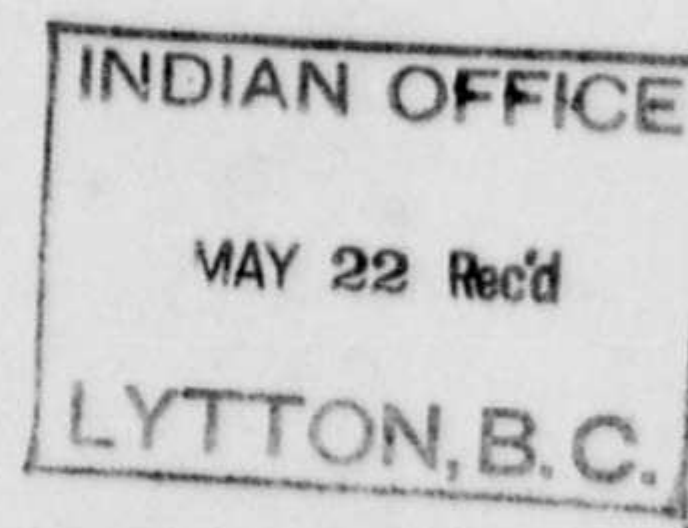
