The Department finds it necessary to return your Vouchers 988 and 989 for a further explanation.

The manner in which the Vouchers have been issued would indicate that you require us to pay the amount stated on the Vouchers direct to Mr. Hamilton. In this connection, I would point out that we forwarded the Reverend Principal an accountable advance of \$1,500.00 to pay the wages of the painters. It is our understanding that he would pay them and that you would then submit Credit Vouchers.

In submitting a Credit Voucher it is necessary that the Return of Labour Form should be signed by each workman, acknowledging receipt of the amount shown on the form.

If these Vouchers are intended as Credit Vouchers, it will be necessary to have each workman sign them, acknowledging payment made to him, and the Vouchers should be clearly marked "Credit Voucher".




