Upon receipt of your communication re Night Watchman,
I sent a note to Mr. Seneca, I enclose his reply.

I feel sure that it will be necessary for the Department to increase
the grant to at least \$50.00 per month in order to secure anyone sufficiently
responsible and trustworthy for the position. Men who can now earn \$2.50
per cord for cutting stove wood will not work a whole month for two weeks
pay.

I beg to suggest that you bring this to the attention of the Indian Affairs
Branch, and request the increase in the grant.

It is very necessary that we have someone on the job as soon as possible
as of course I cannot expect my regular staff to get up during the night
to make the necessary patrols.




