I have the honor to transmit herewith, some correspondence, relative to the compulsory attendance at School of children of non-treaty Indians, which has been exchanged between the Rev. Father Hugonard and Supt. R.B.Deane, Commanding the R.N.W.M. Police at Maple Creek.

Supt. Dean raises the question as to whether this order in council is intended to apply to children of non-treaty Indians. I should be glad to know if this question has been previously raised and what the decision was. I presume the Indians referred to are those non-treaty Indians in the neighborhood of Maple Creek and Medicine Hat
