If, at any time, the salary of Dr. McCaig is increased and it is proposed to pay a portion of it from School Vote for attending the pupils of the Shingwaik Home, it should be remembered that, in the past, he has attended Indian children in the residential school, who belong to the Garden River and Batchewana Bands, without special charge. His salary, which is paid from the Band Funds, has included this service. In the past the School Vote has paid, on file 13-0-13, special accounts which were rendered for services in the case of these pupils who were not from these two bands.

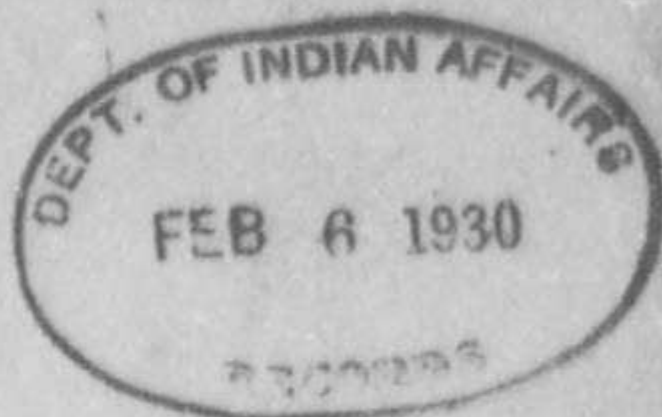

Twenty of our pupils have been treated, Mostly new pupils who came in last Fall, and so represent the worst cases.

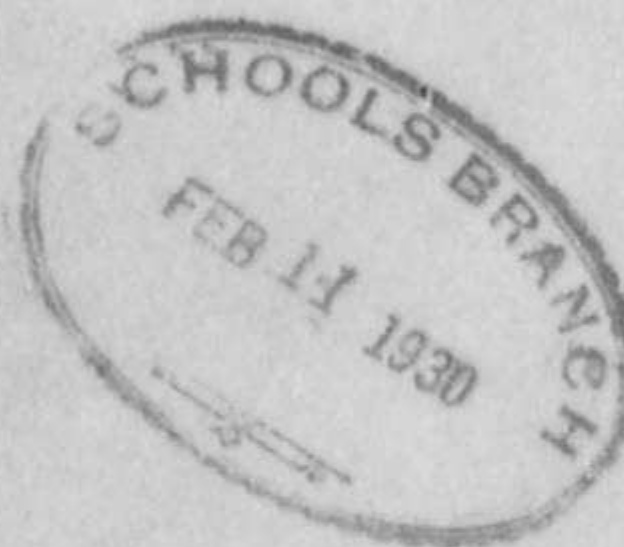

Reverend Sir:

I have your letter of the 4th instant, enclosing an account for \$75.25, in favour of Drs. Shannon & Shannon, of Sault Ste. Marie, for dental work performed for the pupils of the Shingwauk Home. A cheque in payment of this account will be forwarded in due course.

In connection with future dental service for the pupils of your school, I have to inform you that the Department's practice is to insist on only the necessary extractions and inexpensive fillings. In the case of temporary teeth, only extractions can be allowed. The fee set by this Department is \$1.00 per amalgam filling and 25¢ per extraction. When local anesthesia is necessary in extracting, \$1.00 is allowed for the first tooth in the case of each patient and 25¢ for each additional tooth. It is considered that it should not be necessary to use local anesthesia as frequently as appears to have been done, as per charges for this service in the account above referred to.

The accounts for dental attention at this school have been quite large during the past year, and, in future, only the more urgent cases among the pupils should have this work done. The Department will rely on you to see that all cost for dental service is kept as low as possible and that all work carried out is absolutely necessary.

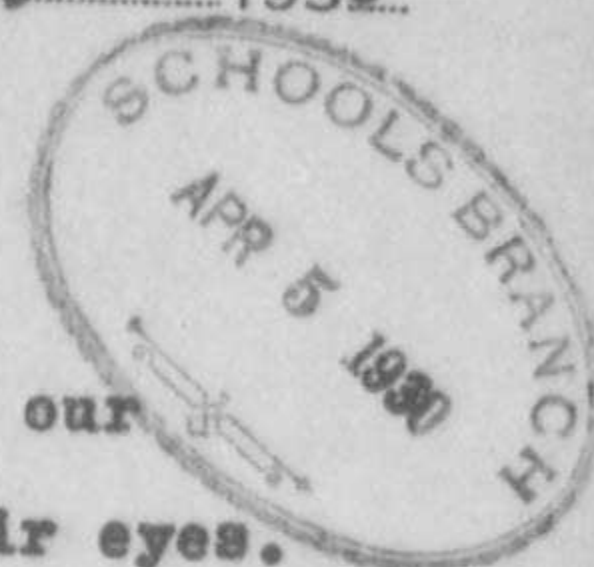
