Department of Indian Affairs,
Ottawa, October 30, 1908.

Sir,-

The Department is desirous of obtaining as complete a return as possible of the actual number of cases of tuberculosis on the reserves in all Indian Agencies. You are therefore requested to arrange with the medical officer of the several bands within your Agency to supply the following particulars at the earliest date possible.

As an examination of the monthly returns too frequently shows reported cases of lagrippe, bronchitis and pleurisy and since medical experience shows that, except when acute, many of these cases prove tubercular, it is hoped that medical officers will be careful by a complete clinical examination to determine the true nature of all such cases, and to include all cases in the return, which by examination of the sputum or by other means prove to be tubercular, in order that the danger of infection from the different classes of cases may be accurately estimated.
