The whole of Lots numbered thirteen (13) and fourteen (14) in the Settlement of Good Hope, as said lots are shown on a plan of said settlement, approved and confirmed on the sixth day of April, nineteen hundred and fifteen, by E. Deville, Surveyor General at Ottawa, of record number twenty-two thousand four hundred and fifty-nine (22,459) in the Legal Surveys and Aeronautical Charts Division of the Department of Mines and Technical Surveys at Ottawa, a copy of which is registered in the Land Titles Office for the Northwest Territories Land Registration District under number thirty-seven (37).

The whole of Lot numbered one (1) in Block numbered one (1) in Fort Franklin Settlement, as said lot is shown on a plan of said settlement, approved and confirmed at Ottawa on the eighth day of September, nineteen hundred and fifty, by Bruce Wallace Waugh, Surveyor General of Dominion Lands, of record number forty thousand nine hundred and thirty-three (40,933) in the Legal Surveys and Aeronautical Charts Division of the Department of Mines and Technical Surveys at Ottawa, a copy of which is registered in the Land Titles Office for the Northwest Territories Land Registration District under number one hundred and thirty-six (136).

Ottawa, a copy of which is registered in the Land Titles Office for the Northwest Territories Land Registration District under number one hundred and forty-one (141).

A parcel of unsurveyed land, being the site of the school buildings in Jean Marie River Settlement situated at the junction of the Jean Marie and Mackenzie Rivers, approximately latitude sixty-one degrees, thirty-one minutes and thirty seconds ($61^{\circ} 31' 30''$) north, and Longitude one hundred and twenty degrees and thirty-seven minutes ($120^{\circ} 37'$) west.

The whole of lot numbered three (3) in the Settlement of Rae, as said lot is shown on a plan of said Settlement, approved and confirmed by Frederic Hatheway Peters, Surveyor General at Ottawa, on the second day of August, nineteen hundred and thirty, of record number thirty-two thousand four hundred and fifty-two (32,452) in the Legal Surveys and Aeronautical Charts Division of the Department of Mines and Technical Surveys at Ottawa, a copy of which is registered in the Land Titles Office for the Northwest Territories Land Registration District under number fifty-four (54).

The whole of lot numbered twenty-one (21) in Talton River Settlement as said lot is shown on a plan of Lots 20 to 33 inclusive, in said settlement, approved and confirmed at Ottawa on the fifteenth day of May, nineteen hundred and fifty, by Bruce Wallace Waugh, Surveyor General of Dominion Lands, of record number forty thousand nine hundred and nineteen (40,919) in the Legal Surveys and Aeronautical Charts Division of the Department of Mines and Technical Surveys at Ottawa, a copy of which is registered in the Land Titles Office for the Northwest Territories Land Registration District under number one hundred and twenty-nine (129).

A parcel of unsurveyed land, being the site of the school buildings in the Settlement of Lac la Martre, situated approximately at latitude sixty-three degrees seven minutes and thirty seconds ($63^{\circ} 07' 30''$) north and longitude one hundred and seventeen degrees thirteen minutes ($117^{\circ} 13'$) west.
