The contract to be signed between the Department of Indian Affairs and this Commission would be on the basis of a 20-year term. The present rates are:

Gross Service Charge - \$1.00 per H.P. per month based on maximum demand with a minimum of 75% of the contracted amount or maximum demand.

Gross Consumption Charge - 4.9¢ per K.W.H. up to the first 50 hours' monthly use of load.

Additional consumption up to the second 50 hours' monthly use - 3.3¢ per K.W.H.

Remaining monthly consumption - 0.5¢ per K.W.H.

Prompt payment discount - 10%.


The transformer, two lightning arresters, and the demand watt-hour meter would be supplied, installed and maintained by this Commission provided the customer furnishes suitable housing for the meter.


Any 110/220 volt secondary lines on the property would be installed and maintained in a suitable manner by the customer.

We believe it would be as well for this Commission to install on behalf of the Department of Indian Affairs at Ottawa the high voltage line.

Dear Sir: Re - N4 D3

We have your letter of the 18th inst. stating that the Department of Indian Affairs at Ottawa wish to receive electric power from this Commission for the Mount Elgin Indian Residential School south-east of Muncey.

We presume that the Department of Indian Affairs at Ottawa would be the proper party to make a contract directly with this Commission, and further to make arrangements for the installation of the primary line on the Indian land from Muncey to the School. We would, therefore, request you to have the Department of Indian Affairs at Ottawa make a request for estimates on the cost of the private primary, 4000 volt, single-phase, ungrounded, two-wire, #6 copper wire. This Commission could install the private line on their behalf, which you say is approximately one mile long, and the Department of Indian Affairs at Ottawa, after considering the estimate, would have to give us authority to proceed and install the line for which they agree to pay all this Commission's costs in connection with the private line.







Dear Sir;

Have just returned from the West, where I visited a number of Industrial schools. The Department is to be congratulated on the splendid equipment furnished the management of these Western schools. We are not a bit jealous, but honestly in necessary things we are greatly behind.

We greatly need some im ediate repairs. About 2,000' of lumber for boys play room boxes, and repairing boy's outside toilets. 1 roll of screen wire for doors and windows, a tinsmith to repair leaky tanks, and a brick layer to make some necessary repairs to broken walls and arches. About \$250.00 in all.

Hoping the Department will see fit to authorize this expenditure at once,
