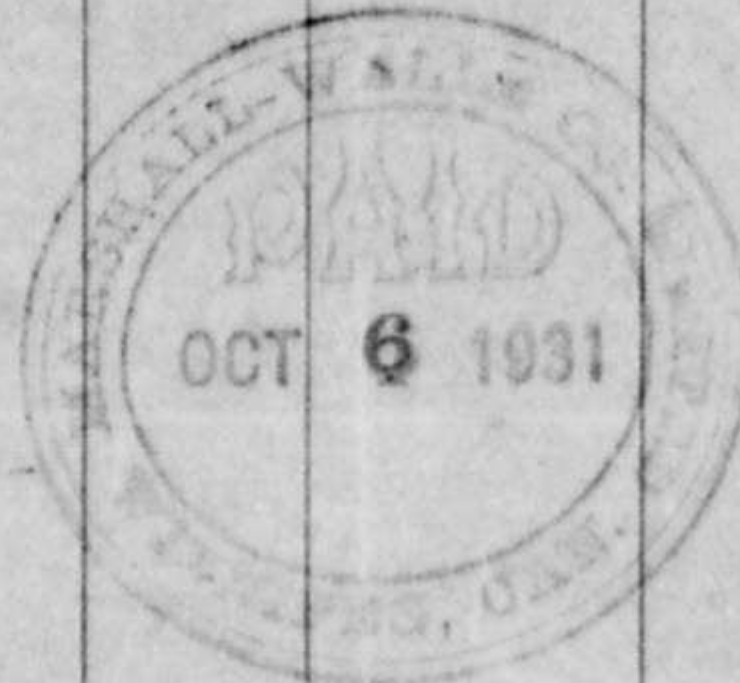

Referring to your letter May the 4th 1932 saying
"not to incur any expenditure which the Department will be
called upon to meet, until you have full directions," I come
to ask you if the department will authorize me to have some
of the work done, which I think is necessary.

1st. Last fall as we were in a hurry
to close the school before the cold season, we did not have
time to scrape off the earth around the building which
caused the rain to remain around the foundation, and which
might cause the concrete to crack. This will take a couple
weeks with two scrapers. It will cost from 40 to \$60.00.

2^o I believe the Department would have no
objection for me to keep a man to get the school ready for
the opening as we have no benches nor tables; and also
as all the other furnitures, such as doors windows have
to be fixed.

I do not find any means of getting the
school ready without the help of a man besides the brother.

You would obliged me very much in telling
me when to send the invoices to the department. Some of the
supply will be here this week; as soon as I will have the
invoice, I will O.K. them and send them to the Department.

You should certify and forward all invoices which you have received covering the cost of furnishings supplied for this school. It is hoped that all the furnishings have reached the school before this date.

Owing to lack of funds, the Department is unable to provide the cost of the services of a man in getting the school ready for opening.
