


DEPARTMENTAL PURCHASING AGENT

Piano for Shubenaadie Indian Day School -

We have received this year many requests for pianos for our Indian day schools. These requests have been rejected and our policy has been to provide only pianos for day schools of at least three rooms and more in size. This policy has been adopted because of the change over in teachers which occurs in our Indian day schools. This has resulted in our providing a piano for a school one year, to find that next year the teacher with musical ability had moved on elsewhere leaving no one capable of using the piano for musical instruction.

To date the only piano authorized for purchase was at the four room Kakasoni Day School. During my recent inspection trip to the Maritimes I advised Mr. Indian Agent Rice to be on the lookout for a cheap reconditioned piano and to try and advise me if possible, so that the necessary purchase order could be obtained. However, this apparently was not possible, as most second hand piano dealers naturally want a decision immediately as to whether the instrument is to be sold or not.

Therefore I would recommend the issuance of a purchase order to cover this reconditioned piano. It has been examined by the music teacher at the school and found to be entirely satisfactory. There will be no difficulty in the Shubenaadie School with regard to a music teacher, as three of the four teachers on the staff are capable musicians.
