Dear Mr Phelan:

Will you please let me know if we have sufficient money in the fund which New England Company has sent over, to replace our School car. I received a letter from Sir Arthur Cochrane last week, in which he said New England Company were increasing the amount of their donation to us from 750 pounds to 1125 pounds. The school car has come to the stage where it will now be a bill of expense. As you are well aware, this part of the country, with its wicked mountain roads is not only very hard on a car, but, unless a car is in first rate shape, driving becomes hazardous. A short time ago, I was driving to Lilloet on important school business, and one of the front wheels came off. Luckily it was on the side furthest away from the four or five hundred foot drop, and so I just ran into the bank. Also, I was by myself at the time.

I would require \$1500.00 to make the replacement on a Chevrolet car, and I would like to have it during the month of July.

I would be very much obliged if you would let me know as soon as possible if this amount would be available at that time.


Dear Canon Hives:

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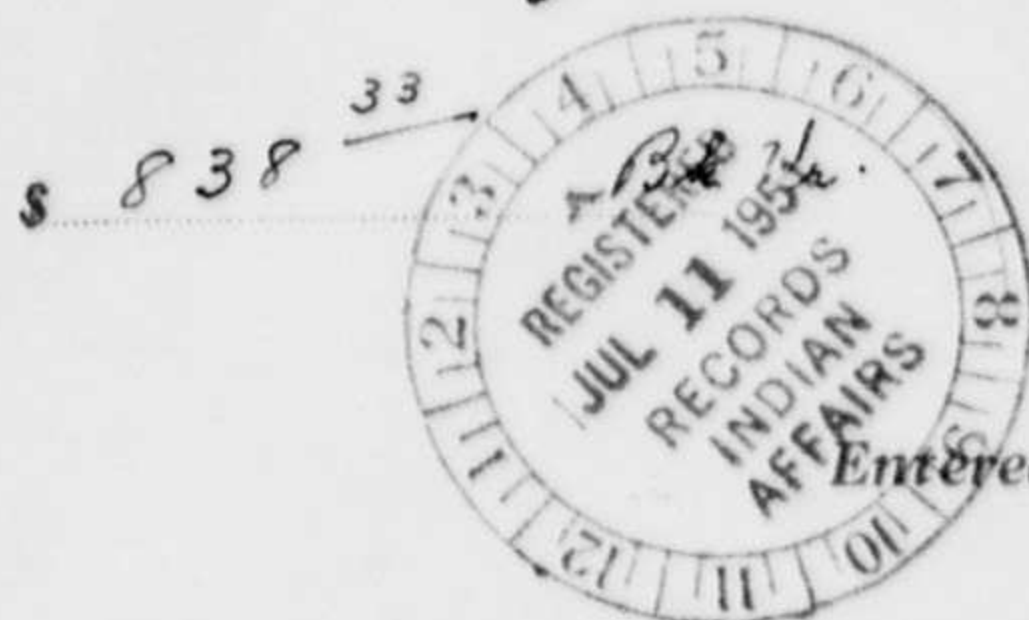
