

Referring to your letter of May 16th (File No. 159-1-5) relative to a farmer's cottage at the Alberni Residential School, B.C., also an assembly hall, you enquire which of these buildings is the more necessary.

On receipt of your letter I at once wrote to Mrs. Clark, the representative of the Woman's Missionary Society who looks after the Indian Work of which this Society has special supervision, and asked her to let me know which building they would rather have erected. I did not have a reply from her in regard to this matter until a few days ago when she gave me to understand that it is her judgment that the farmer's cottage is the more desirable. She seemed to be under the impression that it was already being erected. As to this you will of course have all information. They would be delighted if both buildings could be provided as soon as possible.
