

Ottawa, June 5, 1936.

Dear Mr. Ferguson,-

An amount of \$2,000 is available in this year's appropriation for repairs required to the Kamloops Indian Residential School.

This does not include repairs or alterations to the sewerage system for which work a special amount is being made available, and of which you will be advised at a later date.

It has been suggested that the following repairs are required,-

Painting the roof of the girls' and boys' wings and outside of windows and doors of the entire building.

New toilets in the girls' side of the building.


Miscellaneous repairs.

Under the miscellaneous repairs I think it would be advisable to give consideration to the pointing up of all of the stone coping around the building as if I remember correctly when I visited there last the joints were becoming badly opened.

The following firms are to be employed for this work.

- Painter - R. C. Blackburn of Kamloops.
- Stone Mason - V. Durante " "
- Plumber - Garr and Son " "

If you wish to get estimates from these firms the same will be in order and before commencing the work I will be glad to have your recommendations as to the most urgent work required, within the amount of \$2,000 above mentioned.
