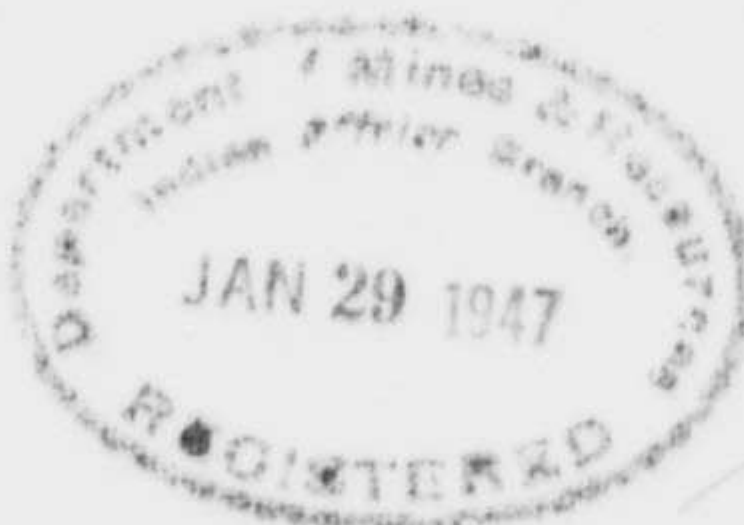

SURVEYS AND ENGINEERING

Care and Maintenance of Electrical Plants  
in Indian Residential Schools.

Our Branch is now publishing a magazine called "The Indian School Bulletin" for all our branch officials, principals and teachers.

It has long been felt that more care should be taken with the electrical and mechanical equipment placed in our residential schools. We have recently received a typical report from the Southern Alberta Electric Limited concerning conditions at two Indian Residential Schools in Peigan Agency. The principal reported to the Agent that twice recently there had been instances of bulbs blowing out and sockets and electric wiring burning. Fortunately, in both instances there happened to be a member of the staff in the room when this had happened. Therefore, Mr. Indian Agent McMillan, in view of the evident fire hazard, called in the above company for an emergency inspection. I attach a copy of the above company's reports on both these schools.

Would it be possible to have an article prepared for a future issue of our magazine entitled "The Care and Maintenance of the Electrical Plants in Residential Schools" so that we may draw to the attention of all concerned the absolute necessity of careful maintenance and common sense in the use of the electrical plants provided.

Your letter and the reports of the Southern Alberta Electric Limited have been received and carefully considered. In paragraph three of your letter you refer to the cost of these reports, but you do not state what the cost is nor were vouchers included.

Your comments concerning the use of fuses of over fifteen amperes are very timely as we are having an article prepared on "The Care and Maintenance of Electrical Plants at Residential Schools" by the Surveys and Engineering Branch for publication in a future issue of the school bulletin.

Sacred Heart Residential School.

1. Globelite GD13 Battery. We have a report from the Globelite Batteries Limited concerning the present battery in use and are endeavouring to obtain a new one for this school.
2. Drop Cords from Ceiling Outlet Boxes. Can you please have estimates made as to the cost of having the present drop cords replaced with new ones.
3. Fire Alarm System. Will you also obtain estimates as to the cost of replacing the present fire alarm system with a complete new system in BX cable direct from the batteries and including proper tamper-proof switches and bells.
4. Fire Escape Lights. Can you please obtain estimates for the marking of the fire escapes with red light bulbs. It will be necessary to have

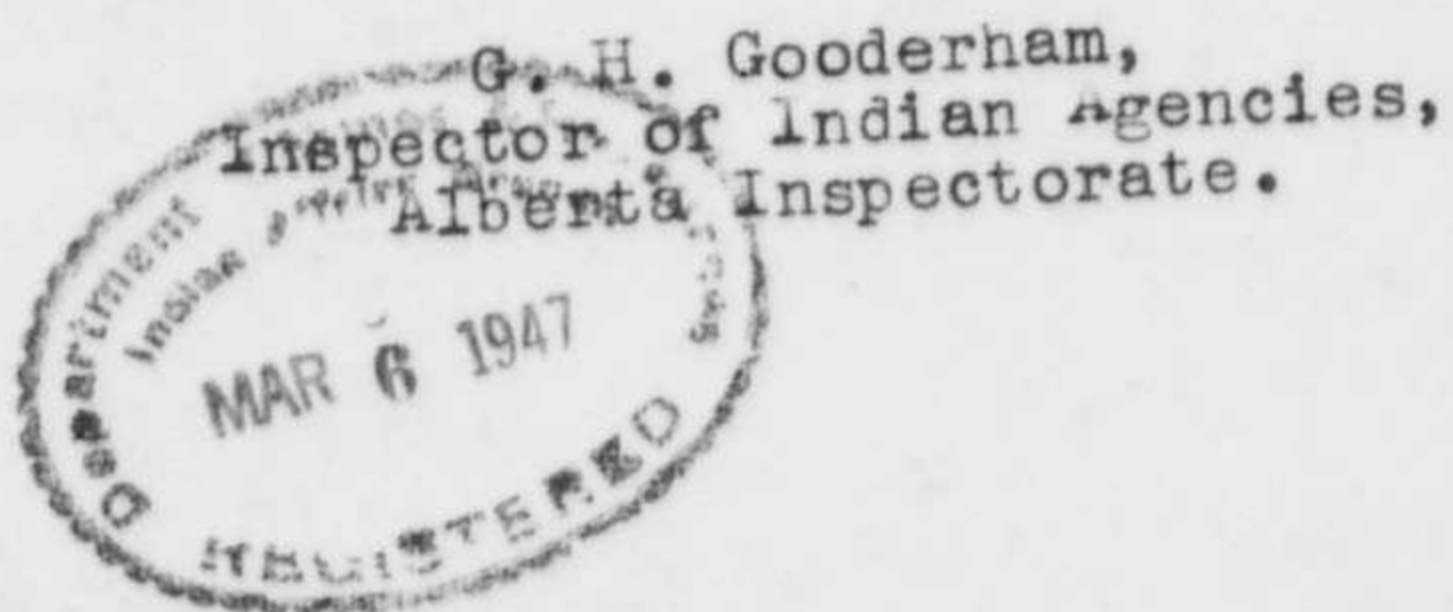
Enclosed herewith please find



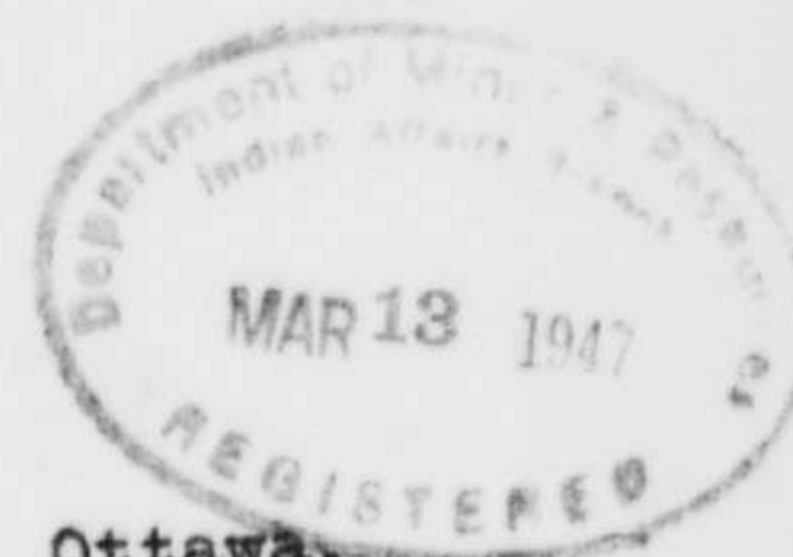

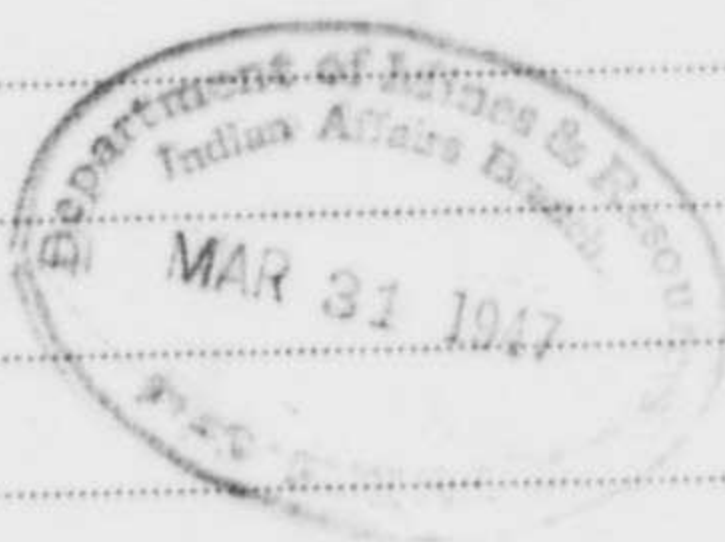

This Engine also needs check up once a year. This Engine will need a new Cylinder head in about a years time, providing engine is looked after and water is not allowed to get low in cooling tank and let Engine get over heated.

Water cooling tank should be replaced immediately as bottom of Tank is rotting and leaking pretty bad, "not dependable". Water jacket on cylinder should be cleaned out once a year on account of Heavy deposit of Lime corrossion caused by the water.

P.S. Shaft should be taken out and have Fly wheel trued up on shaft. Worn on account of being run with loose key. (Key in Engine now was not fitted, and is jammed in Key way.) J.A.Wilson.
