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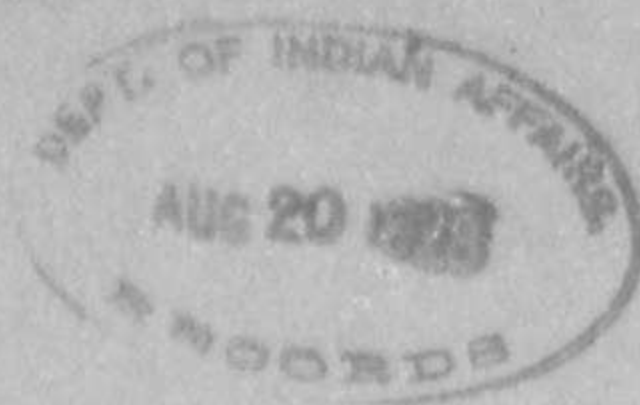

Dear Sir:-

For some time past we have been considering what benefit it would be if we could have a branch of the Canadian Cadets formed here in our school.

We need very much something to teach the boys to be occupied. To be clean and careful with their clothes, and to take an interest in their general appearance, To teach them to respect themselves more.

We are of the opinion that a uniform would be very valuable for this purpose. Our present system of clothing the boys for Sunday service and special occasions is not as good as it should be. We have nothing uniform for the boys, their suits are of different colors and patterns, and do not look well as pupils of a school.

In this connection we have just received a letter from a firm in Ottawa, stating that they at one time supplied boys suits to the Shingwauk, and that they have still on hand a supply of brass buttons, a sample of which they have forwarded to us. And we wondered if the Department would consider using these in the event of our wishes being granted in regard to the matter of Cadets.

If we could have a branch of the Cadets here The boys would get very much benefit, and the matter of discipline would find a place in the working of the affairs of the school that is very hard to maintain in these strange times our country is passing through. And The suits could be worn only to services on Sunday, and other special time.

Please let us know your wishes in this matter, and we shall ever be thankful.
