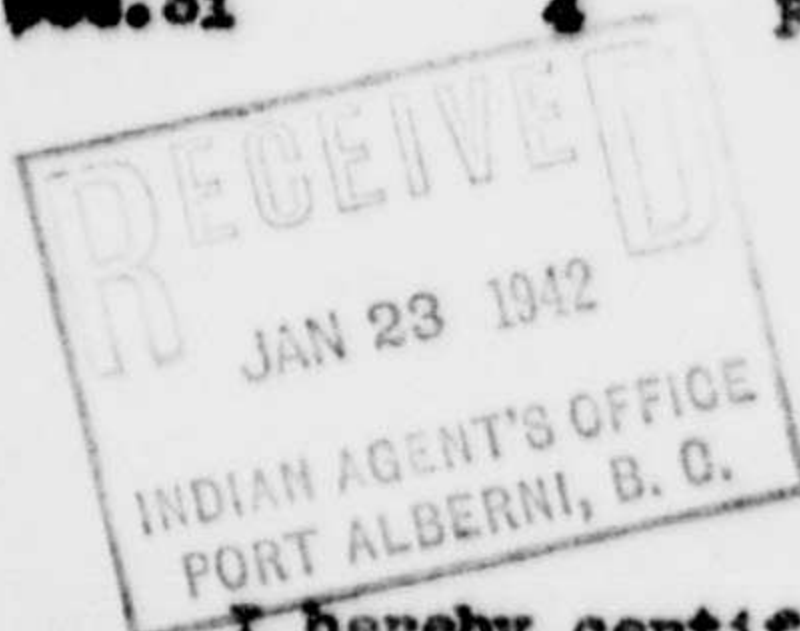

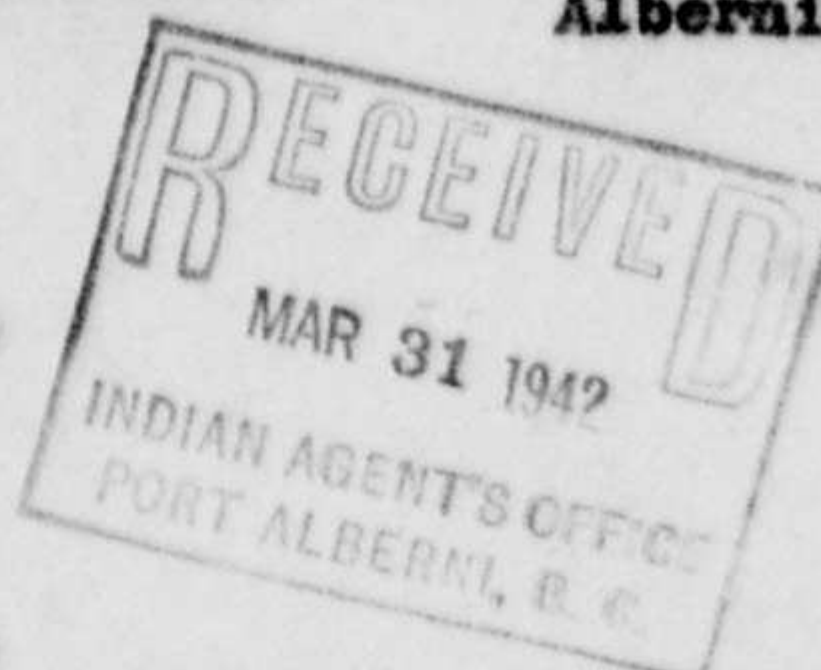

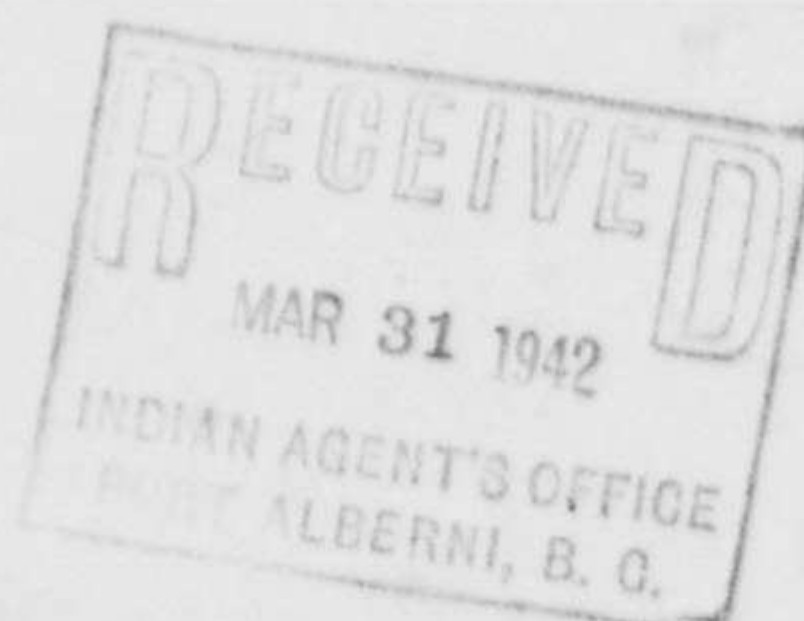

Dear Mr. Hoey:

Some years ago, Mr. Jones of Ahousaht had a boat built, which he called the "Dawn." It seems to have been in some way tied up with the School. The Woman's Missionary Society transferred it to Alberni, where it is in the care of Captain Scott, who will use it in connection with his work and also in helping the boys learn navigation. He has not been able to get registration of the boat for lack of certain documents, the first of which is a Bill of Sale to The United Church of Canada from the builder. This boat was built by Mr. Jones when he was at the Ahousaht School, and the suggestion is that the Superintendent General of Indian Affairs should give a Bill of Sale to The United Church of Canada for the nominal sum of One Dollar. Could you arrange that this be done? If so, I should be glad to get this document as soon as possible, as Captain Scott cannot run the boat until he gets registration, and naturally the customs officers are very strict in these days of war.

Dear Sir:

The former Ahousaht Indian Residential School was located at Ahousaht on the west coast of Vancouver Island, approximately 75 miles north of Port Alberni.

The Ahousaht Indian Residential School was destroyed by fire in January, 1940, and instead of replacing it we erected a new Indian residential school at Alberni. This Indian residential school is managed for us by the United Church of Canada.

Some years ago pupils of the Ahousaht School, under the direction of the Principal, built a boat which was called "The Dawn". The Principal of the Alberni School, Rev. R.C. Scott, advises that this boat has been transferred to the Alberni Residential School but he has been unable to get registration of it owing to lack of certain documents.

In view of the fact that both the Ahousaht School and the Alberni School are Government institutions and both of them have been managed for us by the United Church of Canada, there does not appear to be any reason why Rev. Mr. Scott should experience any difficulty in registering the boat.

With the above facts in mind, I should appreciate your advising what procedure he should follow to obtain registration.
